

Welcome to CC's Learning Camp

This FAQ Sheet has been prepared to answer parent questions about CC's Learning Camp and to help parents decide whether or not it would be a good fit to support their child's education support for fall.

What is the purpose of CC's Learning Camp?

CC & Co. is ready to help your family with the ever-changing school schedules and socialization needed during these times. CC's Learning Camp will provide an environment where children can work on their schoolwork, socialize, & have physical extracurricular activities integrated into their day. This will allow parents to bring their children to a safe & clean space with a facilitator who will oversee and help with your child's daily learning. This program will include daily breaks where they can have snack time & socialize with friends. Masks will be worn by teachers & students to ensure the safety of everyone. We are committed to providing a safe space & program through CC's Learning Camp that will help you and your child be successful in this new school year!

Is this only for children in the WCPSS?

CC's Learning Camp is designed to provide a social environment where children can do their school work and also interact with other children through physical activities. We welcome any student, including Virtual Academy, Plan B Transition, and/or Home Schooled that is 2nd-12th grade and has school work they can do during their time at CC's Learning Camp.

How is CC's Learning Camp different from a school?

CC's Learning Camp is a service offered at CC & Co. Dance Complex, which does not operate under the same guidelines as public schools. As a private organization, we are able to set our own class sizes, 8 per class pod, educational best practices, and standards of care. Our facilitators do have an education background, but are not certified teachers. They are there to provide your student with assistance logging in to their school's program, helping them to navigate through their system, keep them on task, and provide a social outlet throughout the day with physical activities to engage their mind, body, and heart!

Where will CC's Learning Camp be held?

All classes will meet at the main location of CC & Co. Dance Complex which is located at 8863 Six Forks Road. The facility has 6 instructional rooms, an outdoor lunch area, parking, security cameras, state of the art air handling capacity, and outdoor space for physical activities.

What ages can CC's Learning Camp currently serve?

CC's Learning Camp is currently able to serve 7-18 year old students (Gr.2nd-12th). We are exploring options for PreSchoolers and PreK students as well, but do not have those options available at this time. What is the daily schedule?

We have two options: Half days (8:30am-12:30am) or full days (8:30am-2:30pm) for 3 days (M-W-F) or 5 days (M-F). Mornings will be focused on virtual learning (at appropriate lengths for different ages) and late morning/afternoons will be for extended study and/or enrichment activities. There will also be time each day for lunch, physical activity and getting outside.

What do students do for lunch?

Students will bring their own lunch and snacks each day. Weather permitting, lunch will be held in our outdoor picnic area daily.

What are class sizes?

Each class will be limited to 8 students, which will be considered a pod. Each pod will stay together for learning, lunch and enrichment activities to minimize community exposure.

What if I try to register and it's full?

We will keep a waiting list and reach out if a space opens up. Once we get a full waiting list, we will open another pod for that week.

Who will be supervising the students?

Each classroom will be staffed by a facilitator with an educational background whose role is to help the students to log-in to their daily schooling and navigate virtual learning each day. Our facilitator is also there to create a sense of community, foster safe socialization and facilitate daily enrichment activities among learners. In some cases, there will be one facilitator for the morning and one for the afternoon to minimize teacher exposure and to maximize classroom coverage for when subs are needed.

Is there a fee?

Yes, CC's Learning Camp is a fee-based service similar to a day camp or other youth development activities. Registration requires a weekly, non-refundable registration fee of \$5 per week which will hold your space between now and the start of classes. If you register for a full month of classes, you will pay a monthly fee registration fee of \$5.

Weekly and monthly fees are as follows:

- 3 Days
 - Half Day
 - \$75/week
 - \$300/month
 - Full Day
 - \$110/week
 - \$430/month
- 5 Days
 - Half Day
 - \$125/week
 - \$480/month
 - Full Day
 - \$150/week
 - \$600/month (10% discount = \$540)

Beginning the first week of classes, weekly fees for full days will be charged to your account on Monday of each week.

Please note: Tuition is non-refundable once it is drafted. In order to receive an account credit, you must provide a written withdrawal to <u>info@cccodance.com</u> 2 weeks prior to your camp start date. Less than a 2-weeks notice prior to camp will result in ½ price charge to your account or you can pay full price and opt to do a make up day in the future.

What protections and procedures are in place to fight community spread of COVID-19?

CC & Co. Dance Complex follows More Than Just Great Dancing!® Safer Studio[™] policies and procedures which focuses on a hierarchy of measures beginning with avoiding contact with anyone with symptoms, followed by frequent hand cleaning and good hygiene practices, amplified cleaning, and minimizing contact and mingling.

What measures are put in place to foster a sense of normalcy for children in a pandemic world?

The mere act of getting up in the morning, getting dressed and "going to school" can be a significant anchor for a child in a turbulent time. Daily routines are stabilizing for children. Our small class sizes and structure minimize risk and maximize the joyful parts of schools such as socialization. Important routines of school such as classroom greetings, newsletters, enrichment activities and community building are not only still present in our program, they are more important than ever.

Do you do temperature checking?

Our staff is temperature checked on a daily basis. Students will also be temperature checked upon check-in daily.

Will the staff and students have to wear masks?

Our staff have been wearing masks and will continue to do so while the County is in red and orange. The current State Emergency Order #1 allows for instructors to step back more than six feet from students and lower their mask to give large group instructions.

State Emergency Order #1 requires all students over the age of five to wear a cloth face covering while indoors until September 11, 2020. Students do not have to wear a face covering while outdoors if spread out appropriately from other children. Once the emergency order expires, parents will be allowed to make their own decision for their children regarding masks and face coverings unless another order is put into place.

What is your illness protocol?

Staff, parents and students should know the symptoms of COVID-19:

- Fever
- Cough
- Shortness of breath
- Diarrhea (watery)
- Sore throat/congestion
- Headache
- Chills
- Muscle and joint pain (multiple)
- Nausea or vomiting
- Loss of sense of smell

Staff and students should notify CC & Co. Dance Complex administrators and contact healthcare providers if they develop symptoms of COVID-19 or any other illness and will be asked to STAY HOME until they are symptom-free for 72 hours. Any student who becomes unwell during the school day will wait in a special isolation area, which is supervised by a staff member, until a parent or guardian can arrive.

Students or staff who test positively for COVID-19 will follow the country's current recommendations for self isolation. Students may take up to a two week leave of absence and keep their place in the program. If there is a positive report of COVID-19 in our learning community, we will follow the county's current guidelines for notifications.

How do I register?

• Registration has begun! The first priority is to the 5 Day/week students.

• Registration requires a weekly, non-refundable registration fee of \$5 per week which will hold your space between now and the start of classes. If you register for a full month of classes, you will pay a monthly fee registration fee of \$5.
