ZENGER FARM is a 501(c)3 nonprofit working urban farm that models, promotes, and educates about sustainable food systems, environmental stewardship, community development, and access to good food for all.

Short-Season Farm Interns will join the Full-Season Farm Interns in the fields for eight weeks during the summer or fall months. At Zenger Farm, produce is grown and harvested for a 90-member CSA, local restaurants, and one weekly farmers market on four acres of urban farmland. The farm is also home to a flock of laying hens. The Short-Season Farm Internship offers hands-on experience in basic farm skills. This internship will be primarily a hands-on, physical education, but will be supplemented by 10 hours of workshop instruction in sustainable farming practices as well as dedicated training in the fields. Short-Season Farm Interns work closely with the Farm Managers and Full-Season Farm Interns. They are also an integral part of the Zenger Farm community, working at times alongside education staff, youth program participants, and volunteers.

- Tuesdays & Wednesdays, 8:00 am 4:30 pm (with option to come on Thursdays and Fridays)
- SUMMER: June 20th August 10th (with option to extend beyond August 10th)
- FALL: August 22nd October 19th

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Field Work: Most field work at Zenger Farm is done by hand, and includes seeding, planting, weeding, watering, trellising, harvesting, hauling, washing, and packing produce for sale
- Animal Care: Watering, feeding, cleaning, and care of chickens and turkeys
- General Farm Maintenance: Tool and equipment care, farm and property upkeep
- Summer and Fall tasks will differ, please inquire for more information

QUALIFICATIONS

- Must be 18 years or older at start of internship
- Demonstrated interest in gardening/farming
- Physical fitness and ability to lift 50 lbs
- Positive, can-do attitude
- Self-Motivated: Farm work requires physical and mental endurance, and farm days are spent outside in any weather
