Christian Brothers University does not offer standardized testing on campus but taking an admissions test is not difficult to arrange! Go to Educational Testing Service, www.ets.org, to register for the tests required for admissions.

Content knowledge tests (Praxis II) must be taken and passed upon first 12 hours of coursework. Candidate must register for and take the tests within the first 8 weeks of their second semester (within first 4 weeks if summer is second semester) and CBU must receive passing test scores by the end of the 16 weeks of the candidate's second semester (by the end of the 8 weeks if summer is second semester) in order for candidate to continue with any further coursework.
