The CBU Packaging Lab was an ISTA Certified Testing Laboratory from 2009 to 2020. It stopped the commercial testing service in 2020 and 2021 due to COVID-19 pandemic. Now the lab has been recertified by the International Safe Transit Association (ISTA) to perform the following ISTA protocols:

- Non-Simulation Tests: 1A, 1B, 1C, 1D, 1E, 1G, 1H
- Partial Simulation Tests: 2A, 2B, 2C
- General Simulation Tests: 3A, 3B, 3E, 3F, 3K
- Enhanced Simulation Tests: 4AB
- Member Performance Tests: 6-Amazon.com, 6-SAMSCLUB, 6-FEDEX
- Development Tests: 7D

The CBU ISTA Certified Packaging Lab is used in various packaging courses. It is also used to prepare students to become ISTA Certified Packaging Laboratory Technician. Between 2014 and 2020, CBU produced almost 90 certified technicians.
