Description of Accounting

If you plan to pursue a career in the accounting profession, either in public accounting or in a corporate setting, the **Bachelor of Science in Accounting** degree is for you. Your major coursework is designed to prepare you for the Uniform CPA Examination (valid in all states) and for possible business education at the graduate level.

Your classes will focus on financial accounting, managerial accounting, cost accounting, taxation, governmental accounting and auditing. You can also choose to take elective accounting courses, including International Financial Reporting Standards, Fraud Examination and Forensic Accounting. We encourage you to complete an internship in your junior or senior year, which often leads to full-time employment after graduation.
