Description of Management Information Systems

The Bachelor of Science in Business Administration with a concentration in Management Information Systems (MIS) combines Computer Science with core business courses and is designed to provide you with the necessary skill sets in information systems project management, database management, networks, and web development to join the workforce in the various lucrative fields of information technology (IT). Your coursework focuses on topics such as networks and security, systems design and analysis, database design and data mining, web applications and development, and project management.
