#### **Description of Ecology**

The Ecology program is intended for students interested in the environment and combines coursework in Botany, Ecological Census Techniques, Herpetology, Entomology, Toxicology, Parisitology, and Ecology. As an Ecology major you will gain understanding of how natural living systems function, develop and interact with the environment. You will also learn how ecosystems can be managed and conserved. Through your coursework, you gain invaluable experience in experimental design and analysis and become proficient in data analysis. Last but not least, you will have opportunities to present your research at the annual CBU research poster session and at a scientific meeting.
