- Brother Chris Englert first met the Christian Brothers while attending La Salle High School in Cincinnati, Ohio.
- After high school, Brother Chris entered the postulancy* for the Brothers in Glencoe, Missouri, and from there entered the novitiate, taking his first vows in 1974.
- He earned a BA in Humanities at Christian Brothers College (now University) in 1977.
- After graduating college, Brother
 Chris returned to Cincinnati to teach
 English and Religion at his alma mater.

- Brother Chris also served five years in high school administration as
 Dean of Students at O'Hara High School in Kansas City, Missouri.
- Brother Chris was then assigned to Christian Brothers High School in Memphis as Vice-Principal for one year and the next 29 years as CEO (principal/president).
- After serving at CBHS, Brother Chris served as the Auxiliary Provincial for the Midwest District of the Christian Brothers, where he assisted in the ministry to the Brothers and the oversight of the ministries.
- Before being named interim president of Christian Brothers University,
 Brother Chris served on the CBU Board of Trustees from 2011 to 2023.
