

The Basket of Fruit by Caravaggio in its digital version at the Pinacoteca Ambrosiana in Milan

Starting from November 22, 2023, the Basket of Fruit by Caravaggio at the Pinacoteca Ambrosiana in Milan will be replaced by the DAW® (Digital ArtWork, Limited edition number 4 of 9 by Cinello. The installation allows the public to admire the beauty of the painting while the original version is temporarily on loan.

Milan, November 2023 – on November 22, 2023, Caravaggio's Basket of Fruit will leave the permanent collection of the Pinacoteca Ambrosiana in Milan and it will be replaced by the DAW®, Limited edition number 4 of 9, digital and certified version authorized by the museum, providing all the features of the original work thanks to Cinello's internationally patented technology (www.cinello.com).

The Basket of Fruit, painted by Caravaggio between 1597 and 1600, represents the first still life in art history. Given its importance in Pinacoteca's collection, **Cinello's patented technology will allow visitors to enjoy the work** during the absence of the original version which will be temporarily exhibited in Asti at Palazzo Mazzetti.

They are not to be mistaken as NFTs because the original file is protected by a centralized encryption system developed by Cinello and patented under the name MyGal®.

This makes it significantly different from any other form of digital art on the market. The way to display works of art is extremely innovative: in addition to the digital file of the work and MyGal®, the DAW® includes a high-definition monitor and a handcrafted Italian frame, identical to the original one. In this way, the viewer can admire the work anywhere in the world, experiencing the same sensation he would have when visiting the museum where the original work is housed. Each DAW® is accompanied by a certificate of authenticity which guarantees its ownership.
