- Payment required for the Upcoming Month when Intake Paperwork completed.
- Nursing Services require a Physician Order.
- Services can be cancelled with a 2 week written notice and or in the case of death and or moving out of the community.
- Mileage allowance up to 35 miles per week. Additional mileage .50 a mile
- Unused hours are not rolled over into the next month.
- Prices are subject to change with a 30 day notice.
- Each client assigned to 1 Care Leader
- Scheduling will be done with the Care Leader and the Client
- Care Plans will be developed at time of Intake
