Bokkie: Trestle - (Building) a framework in the form of a horizontal member supported at each end by a pair of splayed legs, used to carry scaffold boards, or table top.

Braai: (plural *braais*) is Afrikaans for "barbecue" or "grill" and is a social custom in South Africa, Botswana, Namibia, Lesotho, Swaziland, Zimbabwe and Zambia. The term originated with the Afrikaans-speaking people, but has since been adopted by South Africans of many ethnic backgrounds.

Potjie: literally translated "small pot food", is a stew prepared outdoors that is traditionally cooked in a round cast

BraaiBokkie™:

Doos - Box: A Carton is a container usually made of paperboard or of corrugated fiberboard used for storage or packaging. A carton is also called a **Box**.

Naai: Sewing - Embroidery is the handicraft of decorating fabric or other materials with needle and thread or yarn.

Boknaai: The process of embroidering the logo of the BraaiBokkie™ onto a Shirt, Cap, Apron or other textile.

BraaiBok: The owner of a BraaiBokkie™. This person has the skill and ability to use it. This person will always make a plan to braai or find a reason to use the BraaiBokkie™.

Stukkie: a piece of meat, that is usually cut from the braai grid or taken from the potjie on the BraaiBokkie™ and is shared with friends and guests for tasting purposes.

The lover or spouse of the BraaiBok™ is also his / her Stukkie, but others are usually not invited to taste.
