### **Meet the Music**

Each CMS Kids program is a relaxed performance, an inclusive concert experience in a judgment-free environment. This performance is less formal and more supportive of sensory, communication, movement, and learning needs.

- *Who is Brahms?* – 3:00pm March 1, 2020
- *Master Work: Brahms’s Rondo alla Zingarese, Op. 25* – 11:00am, 3:00pm April 26, 2020

### **Chamber Music Beginnings**

Music and culture come to life in this series of entertaining, interactive concerts. Students learn about the elements of music – melody, rhythm, form, artistry, and expression – first hand from our musicians and teaching artists. Students also discover the intimacy of chamber music and the values of cooperation, teamwork, and personal responsibility essential to a successful performance.

- *Making Melodies* – Nov 19, 2019 (Flushing Town Hall, Queens); Nov 20, 2019 (Merkin Hall at Kaufmann Music Center)
- *Finding Forms* – Mar 10, 2020 (Flushing Town Hall, Queens); Mar 11, 2020 (Merkin Hall at Kaufmann Music Center, Manhattan)
- *Classics in Your Classroom* – April to June 2020 (performances in your school!)

Ever wonder how professional musicians prepare for a concert? We invite you and your students to attend a real working rehearsal as our artists get ready for one of our concerts. Each rehearsal lasts approximately one hour and is preceded by a 30-minute introduction to familiarize students with the repertoire they are about to hear. All events take place in the Rose Studio.

- Bach: Brandenburg Concertos (1720) – 10:30am Thursday, December 12, 2019
- Schumann: Quintet in E-flat major for Piano, Two Violins, Viola, and Cello, Op. 44 (1842) – 10:30am Friday, March 6, 2020

### Middle School Music Up Close (grades 6-8)

- Farina: *Capriccio stravagante* for Violin, Two Violas, Cello, and Continuo (1627) – 10:30am Friday, December 6, 2019
- Mozart: Quartet in G minor for Piano, Violin, Viola, and Cello, K. 478 (1785) – 10:30am Thursday, March 19, 2020
