KAYAKING SAFETY RULES

- 1. Adult participants and parents/guardians of minors must complete the Harris County Precinct 3 waiver prior to paddling.
- 2. U.S. Coast Guard approved Personal Flotation Devices (life jackets) must be worn snug by all occupants at all times.
- 3. Kayak paddlers must be at least 13 years old. All minors must paddle with an accompanying adult.
- 4. No pets will be allowed in the kayak. Park staff reserve the right to not allow any passengers based upon safety and water conditions.
- 5. Never stand up in the kayak.
- 6. In the event of thunder or lightning, return immediately to the launch. Staff will determine safe return to the water, a minimum of 30 minutes after last lightning/thunder.
- 7. Alter staff immediately of capsized vessel and kick-swim it to shore.
- 8. Be courteous of fishermen and other users by giving them a wide berth.
- 9. Communicate clearly with other paddlers to avoid collisions. Horseplay will not be allowed.
