## **Description:**

Safe crossings are designed in a way that prioritises people walking and cycling, making it easier to cross streets with high levels of traffic. Zebra, parallel or signalised crossings can be used depending on the volume of traffic.

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## **Advantages:**

Safe crossings over busy roads are essential for connecting neighbourhoods together and help make it easier to make longer journeys by walking and cycling.

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## **Disadvantages:**

Zebra, parallel and signalised crossings can slow down bus journey times if buses operate on that stretch of road. They can also be expensive due to constraints, such as drainage, utilities and signal installation.

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## **Trial:**

Crossings can't be introduced on a trial basis due to high costs associated with installation.
