Description:

A diagonal modal filter can be introduced at a crossroad. This prevents motor vehicles from travelling straight across the junction but allows vehicles to turn.

Advantages:

Diagonal modal filters take away the need to reverse, helping larger vehicles to get through the new road system.

Disadvantages:

Diagonal filters don't deliver the same placemaking outcomes of a full modal filter, because some traffic flow is retained.

Trial:

Diagonal modal filters can be trialled using low-cost materials such as wooden planters.
