#### Dear Resident,

#### 100 Woodside Avenue: Construction work during the festive period and early 2024

As you will hopefully be aware, Haringey Council is building 41 new homes, including 32 high-quality council homes, at 100 Woodside Avenue (the site of the former Cranwood House care home). These new homes are part of the council's ambitious home building programme that aims to build a new generation of council homes for local residents.

## Details of the upcoming works

As we advised in our last newsletter, the autumn has seen increased activity on the site as

Formation Design and Build Ltd, the contractor we are employing to build the new homes, has worked to prepare the site for construction work.

In the next few weeks, we expect:

- Formation Design and Build Ltd have advised us that there will be no construction activity between Christmas and New Year, from Thursday 21 December until Monday 8 January, when work will resume.
- During this period, Formation
   Design and Build Ltd will ensure the
   site remains secure with staff onsite, but no building or other work will take place.

### Working times on the site

The working hours for construction on the site until the 21 December 2023 and after the 8 January 2024 will be:

- Monday to Friday: 8am to 6pm
- Saturday: 8am to 1pm

#### Deliveries to the site

Deliveries will be <u>restricted</u> to these hours when construction work is taking place (no deliveries will occur between 21 December 2023 and 8 January 2024):

Monday to Friday: 9.30am to 3pm

Saturday: 8am to 1pm

Deliveries will be carefully scheduled to avoid lorries standing near the site entrance. During traffic movements into and out of the site, Formation Design and Build Ltd will have a designated traffic officer guiding the vehicles into and out of the site. When necessary, the pavement crossover will be temporarily closed for a few minutes to ensure the safety of pedestrians and other road users.
