Thank you to all community members who have shared feedback to date. We are excited to share an update on the latest developments regarding the Kilburn Grange Park Masterplan and improvements!

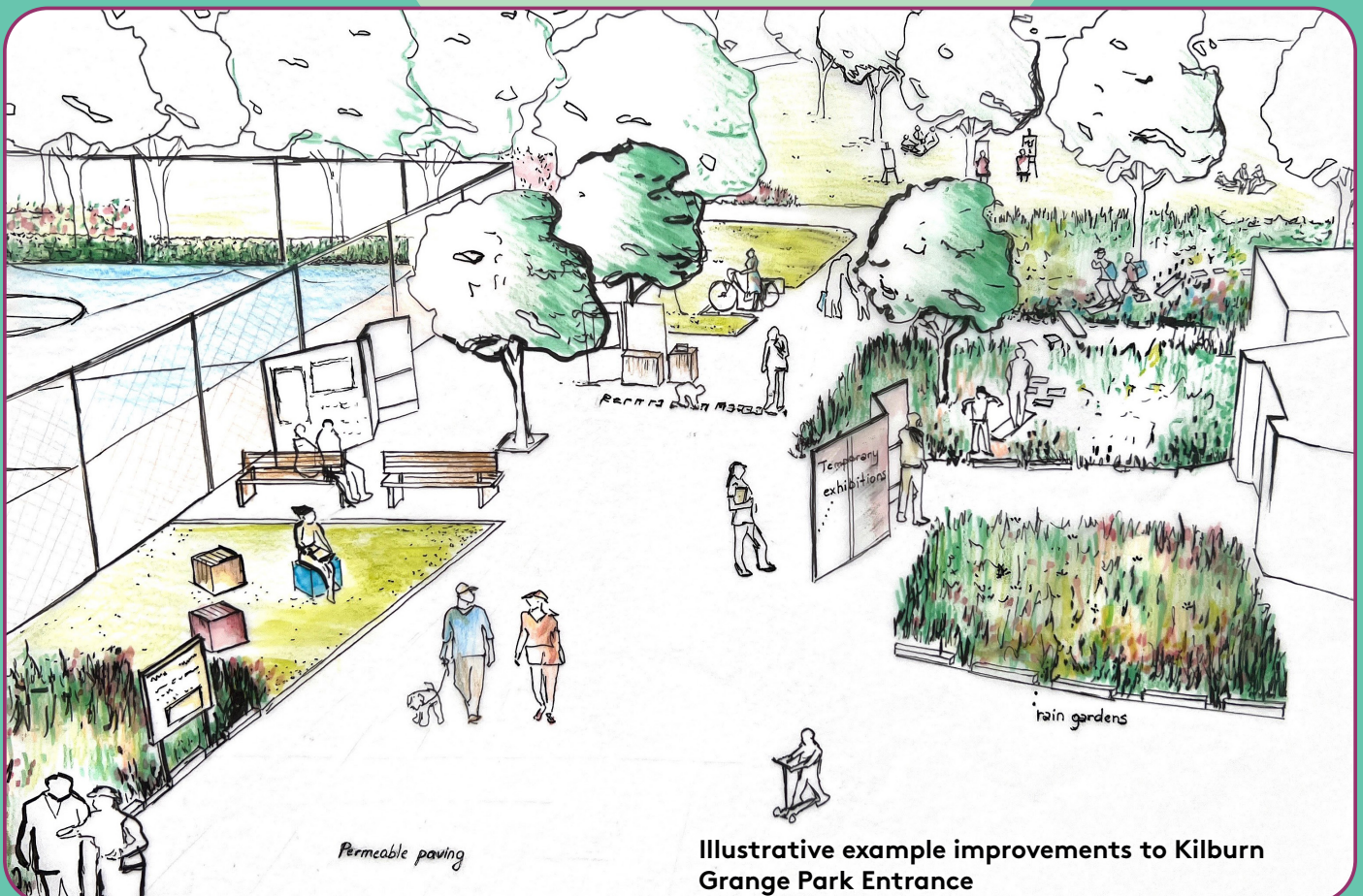
Following the community engagement process in 2023, which was supported by the Mayor of London, Camden has received funding for improvements to the main park entrance from Kilburn High Road.

# WHAT'S HAPPENED SO FAR?

Throughout November 2022 - March 2023, we spoke to local stakeholders, residents and community members of Kilburn to help update the park's masterplan. This plan is used as a guiding vision for improvements to the park, and helps secure funding.

We communicated with people and gathered feedback through:

- One-to-one meetings
- Digital surveys
- Pop-up events
- Website updates
- Public workshops
- Direct emails
- Public exhibitions
- Printed flyers

## YOUR FEEDBACK

Your feedback on the wider masterplan was across three key themes:




### CLIMATE RESILIENCE

-  Improved drainage and sheltered spaces so the park can be enjoyed whatever the weather
-  More colourful, seasonal wildflower planting, particularly in the edge spaces
-  More planting and signage to engage and educate people about local biodiversity and climate action

### HEALTH & WELLBEING

-  Improved junior playground
-  Use play spaces to engage young people with nature and have facilities for those with different needs
-  Refurbished MUGA and create informal exercise spaces for people with different needs
-  Quieter, more reflective spaces to help residents' mental wellbeing

### SUPPORTING THE COMMUNITY

-  A reopened affordable community café, which would have toilets and act as a hub for local groups.
-  An outdoor multi-purpose performance space to support local culture and heritage, along with opportunities for art and creativity
-  Support for existing groups to run projects, events, and to build their membership and visibility.

# WHAT'S HAPPENING NOW?

## PROPOSED ENTRANCE IMPROVEMENTS

Funding has been secured to improve the entrance to the park off Kilburn High Road. This government funding is part of a wider project to help improve the High Road area over the next year.

The initial ideas for improvements have been shaped by your feedback and include:

- A more welcoming entrance for the community
- Improved drainage and sheltered spaces for year-round enjoyment
- More colourful, seasonal wildflower planting in edge spaces
- Planting and signage to engage and educate about local biodiversity and climate action

We are excited to talk to you about these changes.

The changes to the entrance will be based on community feedback from the masterplan, and further upcoming engagement.

Initial ideas include removing the front gates to the park, to create a more welcoming entrance and more usable space.

We're excited to be talking to and working with the community to further these ideas.
