

# COCK ROAD RIDGE



### ENTRANCE IMPROVEMENTS FROM HOLLYGUEST ROAD

Replace old barriers with accessible kissing gate with access for mobility vehicles.



### WILDLIFE POND ENHANCEMENTS

Tree management to let more light into the pond and improve wetland habitat.



### WORKING TOWARDS LOCAL NATURE RESERVE STATUS

An official status to preserve this green space and declare Cock Road Ridge as a special place for wildlife.



### ENTRANCE IMPROVEMENTS FROM COCK ROAD

Replace aged entrance barriers with accessible kissing gates wide enough for pushchairs, with access for mobility vehicles.



### WILDFLOWER BULB PLANTING

Colours and pollen added through bulb planting – chance for community and local schools to help.



### IMPROVING OUR MEADOWS

Wildflower seed sowing and planting to increase the biodiversity of grassland, welcoming more nature to the reserve.



### RIDGE WALK: PATH IMPROVEMENTS

Extending the length of hard-surfaced path to create a circular route through the north-east side of the reserve.

### SMALL MAMMAL PASS

The safe mammal pass would follow pedestrian footbridge over A4174.



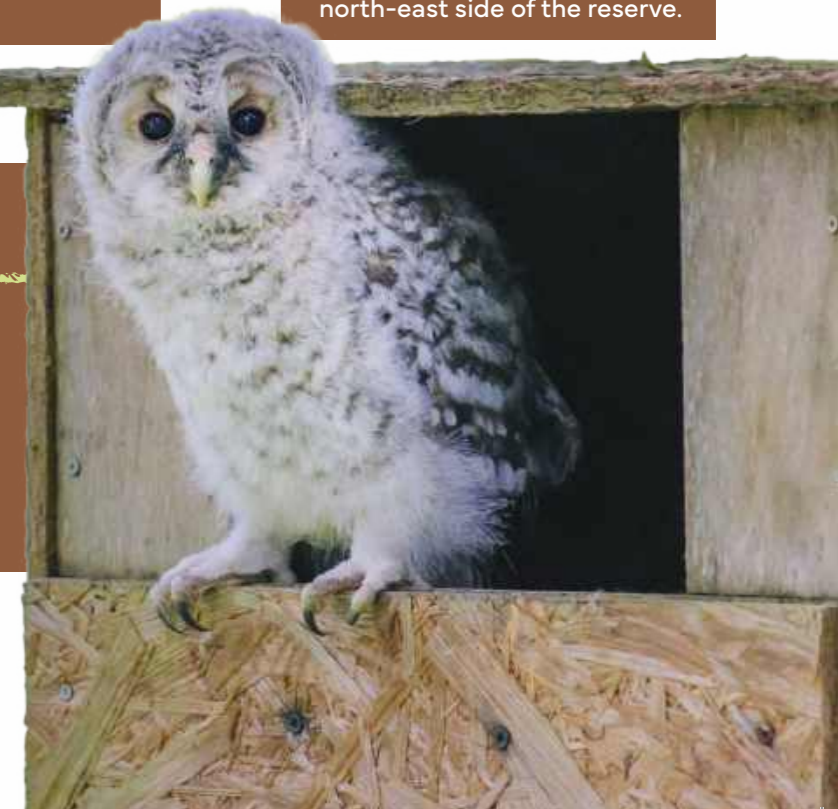
### MAIN ORCHARD

Maintain fruit trees for community and cut back scrub to ensure light. Fence orchard.



### MANAGING THE SITE FOR NATURE

Monitoring and managing scrub to maintain habitats variety on edge of woodland and grassland. Installing nesting boxes for tawny owls.



### SUSTAINABLE DRAINAGE SOLUTIONS

Incorporate existing pond into new drainage scheme, creating wet grassland to slow water flow and boost habitats.



### IMPROVE LINKS WITH LEISURE CENTRE

New steps and stone path gives better visitor access with improved signposts.
