Documents

- Passport or ID
- □ Health insurance card
- $\hfill\square$ $\hfill Driving licence, international driving licence in some countries$
- Booking confirmations
- □ Address book including emergency contacts and emergency numbers
- □ Visa and health insurance confirmation
- □ Letter of protection for car insurance and travel insurance
- □ Vaccination record
- □ **Tickets** for travel
- □ Vignette or toll card
- □ **Other documents**, e.g. tickets and discount cards

Find out about the entry conditions in good time. It is best to make **copies of the important documents**. Keep **originals in your hotel room's safe**.

Money

- □ **Bank card** and **credit card**. Always pay in the currency of the country. Find out about the possible surcharges before you leave. Important: prepaid credit cards are not accepted everywhere.
- Cash. Depending on the country, you should exchange your currency in Switzerland before you leave. Find out about exchange rates in good time.
- □ Access data for your **online banking**.
- □ Emergency telephone number of the bank. Write them down in two different places. In the event of theft, you can have the cards blocked.

Medication

- $\hfill\square$ Remedies for diarrhoea and nausea
- □ Remedies for **constipation**
- □ Thermometer
- □ Cold remedies and nasal spray

- □ Allergy medication
- □ Remedies for **insect bites**
- □ **Tick remedy**, depending on the destination and season. To remove ticks, you need **tweezers** or **tick remover card**.
- □ Remedies for **sunburn** (such as after sun)
- Plasters for blisters

Important: check which medicines you can take into your country of travel before you travel. Some over-the-counter remedies available in Switzerland are prohibited in other countries.

Clothes

- Underwear and socks
- Pyjamas
- □ **T-shirts** and **tops**
- Blouses or shirts
- □ Trousers
- □ Skirts and dresses
- □ If necessary, **tights**
- Pullovers
- □ Rain jackets
