

# Dog pharmacy supplies for emergencies

## Dressing material

- ☐ Gauze bandages
- ☐ Elastic bandages
- ☐ Self-adhesive bandages
- ☐ Cotton wool
- ☐ Swabs
- ☐ Sterile compresses
- ☐ Dressing packets for pressure dressing
- ☐ Adhesive tape or plaster rolls
- ☐ Bandage scissors

## Medication

- ☐ Disinfectant spray
- ☐ Saline for rinsing
- ☐ Wound ointment
- ☐ Charcoal tablets or activated charcoal for poisoning and diarrhoea
- ☐ Diarrhoea medication
- ☐ Vaseline for inserting the fever thermometer
- ☐ Dog's medication

## Other aids

- ☐ Disposable gloves
- ☐ Disposable syringes
- ☐ Disposable razor to remove fur from the wound area
- ☐ Tweezers
- ☐ Tick tweezers
- ☐ Wooden spatula
- ☐ Cool pack
- ☐ Emergency blanket or thermal foil
- ☐ Fever thermometer
- ☐ Torch
- ☐ Small plastic bags: this allows you to collect samples of a poison, for example. You can also use it as a garbage bag.
- ☐ Muzzle or chin loop
- ☐ Dog shoe or baby sock
