The Role

The Candidate

Applicants for a 6 months internship minimum (or an apprenticeship) will be considered.

The preferred candidate should be a self-starter, ideally already familiar with project finance and/or corporate finance at least through his/her academic background and possible first experience, have a strong interest in the sustainable infrastructure sectors the company targets, and be interested in joining a growing platform with a strong team spirit.

- Project finance analysis and excel modelling skills: ability to run complex project/corporate finance / valuation excel models under supervision, at high quality standards. Prior financial modelling experience and practice during academic training will be a strong advantage to be considered;
- Ability to produce high quality presentation materials, sometimes in a high pressure
- Attention to detail, professional discipline and rigor;
- Ability and desire to manage multiple tasks and projects;

A first internship experience in the project finance / M&A department of an investment bank, a private equity / investment firm, or the transaction support/audit or valuation team of a 'Big 4' or equivalent firm is a clear plus. The right candidate will be rapidly exposed to a wide range of assignments and longer term opportunities may therefore arise for the right candidate.
