COVID-19 Hospital Transfer Form for Adults with Intellectual and Developmental Disabilities, [TOOL] Developmental Disabilities Primary Care Program, Surrey Place, Toronto

The COVID-19 Hospital Transfer Form is designed for family and other caregivers of adults with intellectual and developmental disabilities. In the event of a hospital admission for COVID-19, this form communicates essential information to hospital staff, including medical information, substitute decision-maker contacts and information about support needs. It promotes the accommodation of a person's unique communication and behavioural support needs in health care. It is recommended to prepare this form in advance of a COVID-19 emergency and have it available upon a transfer to the hospital.

This tool guides caregivers of adults with intellectual and developmental disabilities (IDD) through the process of advance care planning regarding possible medical treatments for COVID-19. Advance care planning is a process that promotes person-centred care of patients by clarifying their present goals and values, and their preferences for future health care. For adults with IDD, this process involves the adult's substitute decision maker, a healthcare provider, and others who know the adult well, whom the adult trusts, and who are willing to support this process.
