New affordable housing for seniors who have experienced homelessness





A NEW SENIOR HOUSING DEVELOPMENT

Mercy Housing California is creating a new affordable apartment homes community designed for seniors (62 years and older) who have experienced homelessness. Located at 14536 Burbank Boulevard, near the intersection of Burbank and Van Nuys Boulevard, Burbank Boulevard Senior Housing will feature 55 rental apartments, including one management unit, a community room, and social services and property management offices. Other amenities include laundry rooms, drought-tolerant landscaping, a resident roof deck garden, and subterranean parking. Seniors are among the most vulnerable in the homeless population and, sadly, the ranks of homeless seniors surged by 22% in 2018 even as the overall number of homeless in L.A. County dropped.*
