

Special Permit Application – The Lanterns at Warren Woods, 466 Chestnut St **Planting Palette** – Update 9/17/15

Plantings at The Lanterns at Warren Woods will be designed in several general “categories” of planting, as described below. Please note that plant lists are not yet final, and may include other appropriate plants or exclude some plants below as the design progresses. These lists are provided for informational purposes regarding the general character and intent only.

Supplemental Understory Plantings: Native shrubs and small trees typical of woodland edges, such as:

<i>Amelanchier canadensis</i>	Shadbush
<i>Cornus racemosa</i>	Gray Dogwood
<i>Cornus sericea</i>	Red Twig Dogwood
<i>Hydrangea quercifolia</i>	Oakleaf Hydrangea
<i>Ilex glabra</i>	Inkberry
<i>Juniperus virginiana</i>	Eastern Red Cedar
<i>Kalmia latifolia</i>	Mountain Laurel
<i>Picea glauca</i>	White Spruce
<i>Pinus strobus</i>	White Pine (including mass plantings of seedlings)
<i>Rhododendron maximum</i>	Rhododendron
<i>Thuja occidentalis</i>	American Arborvitae
<i>Viburnum dentatum</i>	Arrow-wood
<i>Viburnum trilobum</i>	American Cranberrybush Viburnum

Hedgerow Plantings: Native trees and shrubs typical of farm windbreaks, such as:

<i>Acer negundo/rubrum/saccharinum/saccharum</i>	Native Maples (Box Elder, Red, Silver, Sugar)
<i>Amelanchier arborea or canadensis</i>	Serviceberry / Shadbush
<i>Cornus racemosa</i>	Gray Dogwood
<i>Juniperus virginiana</i>	Eastern Red Cedar
<i>Liquidambar styraciflua</i>	Sweetgum
<i>Nyssa sylvatica</i>	Black Gum / Tupelo
<i>Picea glauca</i>	White Spruce
<i>Pinus strobus</i>	White Pine
<i>Quercus rubra</i>	Red Oak
<i>Viburnum trilobum</i>	American Cranberrybush Viburnum

Street Trees: Hardy large shade trees, such as:

<i>Acer rubrum</i>	Red Maple
<i>Liquidambar styraciflua</i>	Sweetgum
<i>Liriodendron tulipifera</i>	Tulip Tree
<i>Platanus x acerifolia</i>	London Plane Tree
<i>Quercus rubra</i>	Red Oak
<i>Tilia tomentosa</i>	Silver Linden
<i>Ulmus american 'Valley Forge'</i>	American Elm, cultivar resistant to Dutch Elm

Ornamental Trees within each cluster: Native or non-invasive ornamental trees such as:

<i>Amelanchier laevis</i>	Shadblow
<i>Betula nigra</i> 'Little King'	Dwarf River Birch (cultivar of a native)
<i>Cornus x 'Stellar Pink'</i>	Hybrid Dogwood (native/non-native cross)
<i>Crataegus phaenopyrum</i>	Washington Hawthorn (native)
<i>Magnolia loebneri</i> 'Leonard Messel'	Magnolia
<i>Oxydendrum arboreum</i>	Sourwood (native)
<i>Prunus x 'Okame'</i>	Okame Cherry
