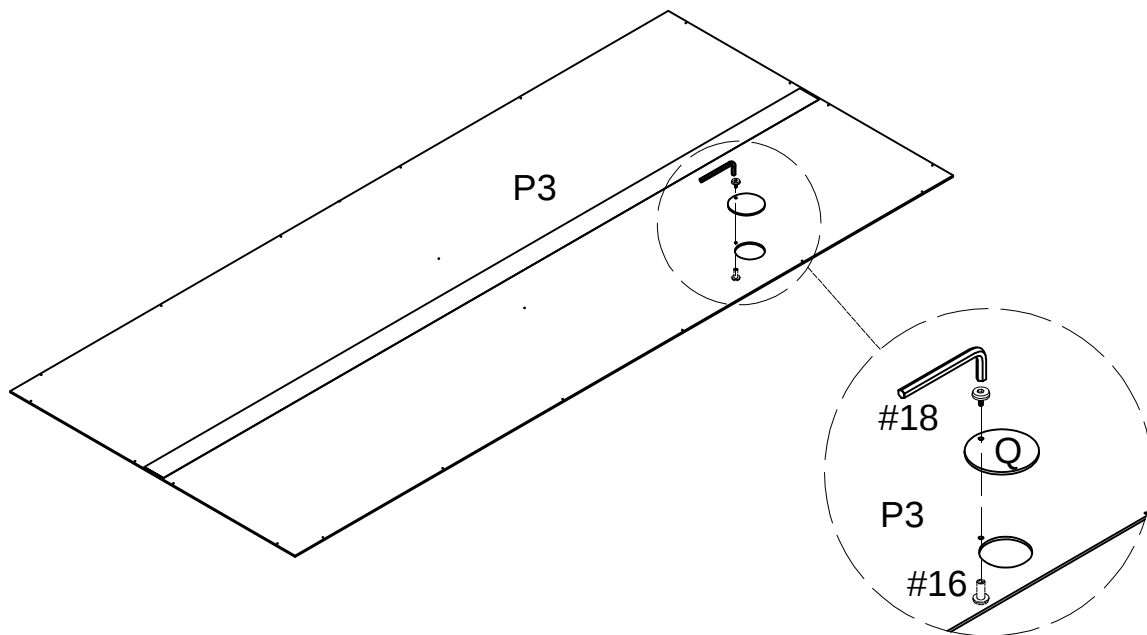
Note: It is not recommended to use power tools during assembly.



Phillips Head Screwdriver

Note: Wood dowels are intended for alignment. Additional clearance between wood dowel and pre-drilled hole is intentional for ease of assembly.

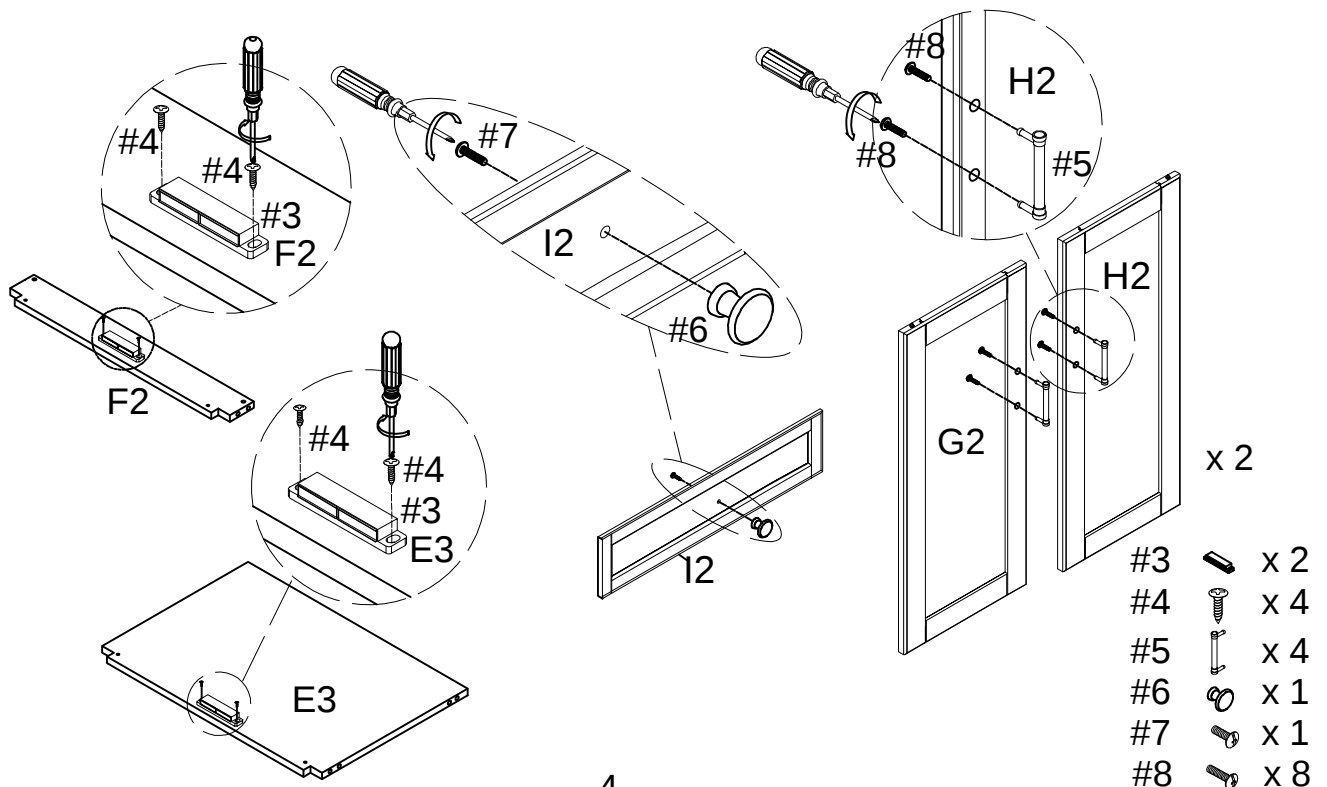
Step 1. Attach cover (part Q) to back panel (part P3) using binding post (part #16) and small allen wrench (part #18).

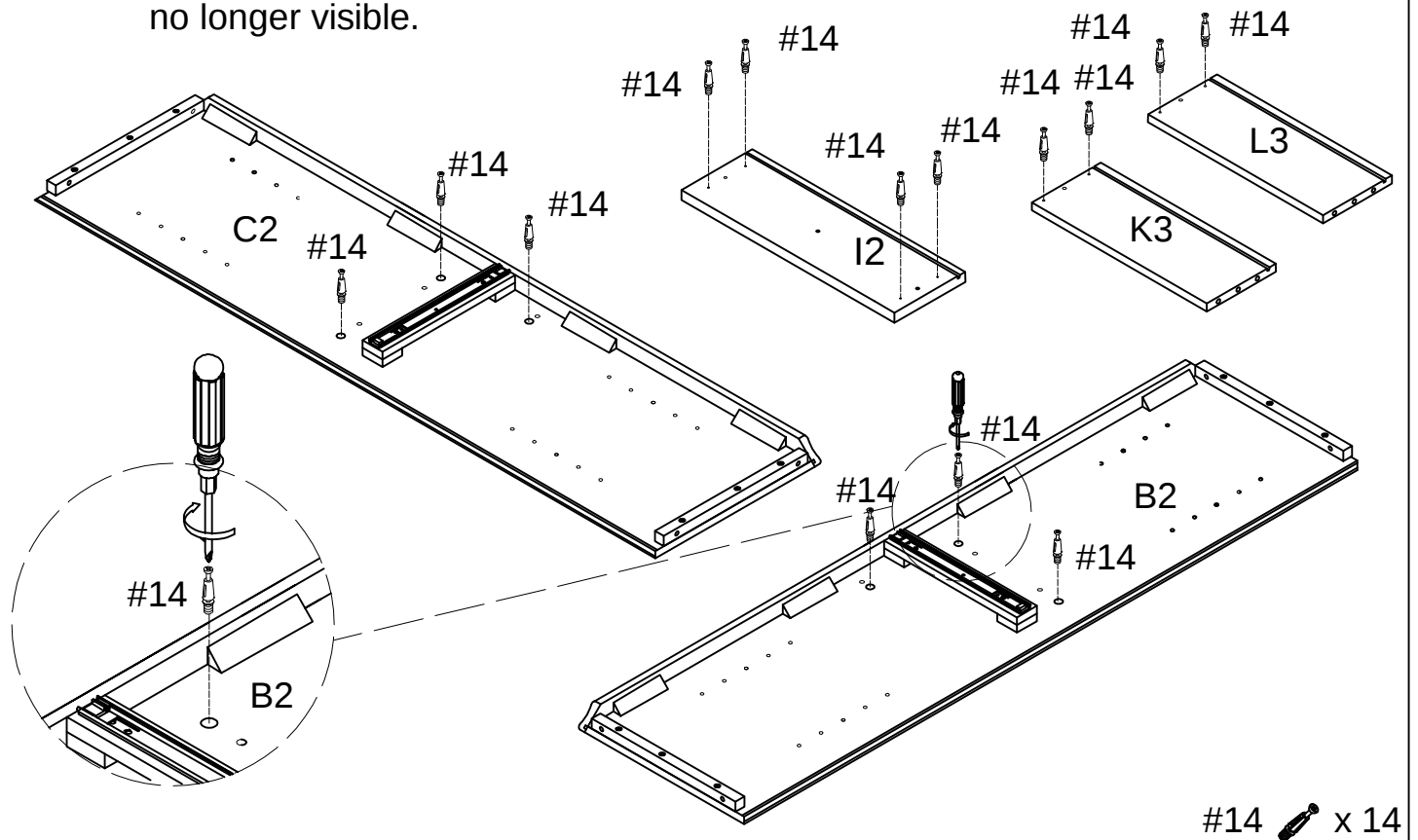

Step 2. Attach double magnets (part #3) to fixed shelf (part E3) and rail (part F2) using round head screws (part #4) and phillips head screwdriver. Attach handles (part #5) to doors (parts G2 & H2) using long round head bolts (part #8) and phillips head screwdriver. Attach knob (part #6) to drawer front panel (part I2) using short round head bolt (part #7) and phillips head screwdriver.



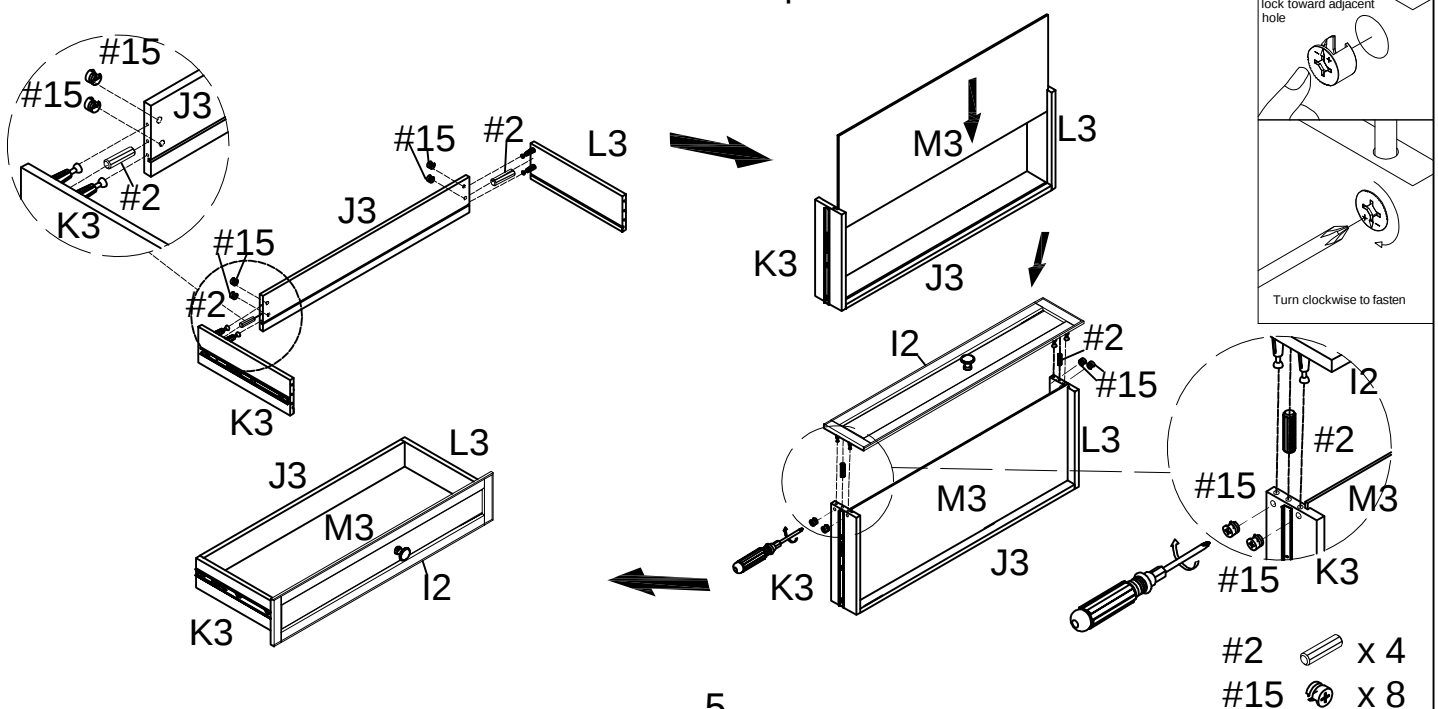
Step 3. Insert cam bolts (part #14) into pre-drilled holes of panels (parts B2, C2, I2, K3 & L3) using phillips head screwdriver.

Note: Do not overtighten cam bolts. Stop tightening once threads on cam bolts are no longer visible.



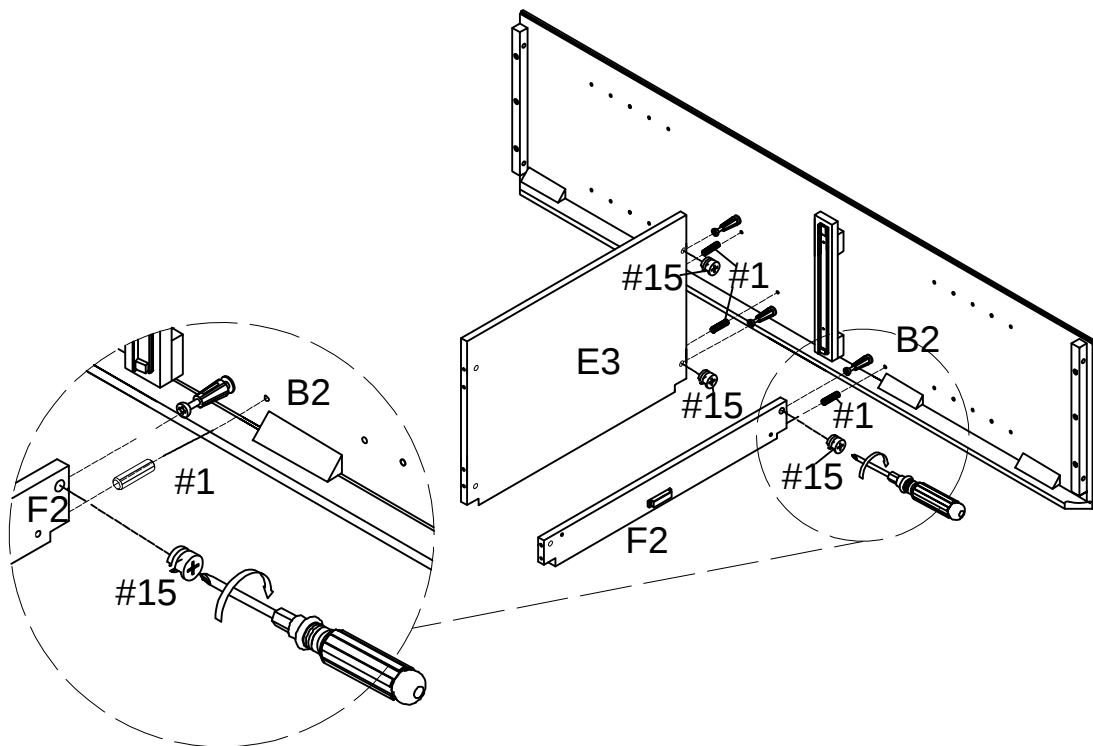
Step 4. Attach drawer panels (parts K3 & L3) to drawer back panel (part J3) using small wood dowels (part #2), cam locks (part #15) and phillips head screwdriver. Slide drawer bottom panel (part M3) into grooves of assembled unit (parts J3, K3 & L3). Attach drawer front panel (part I2) to assembled unit (parts K3, L3 & M3) using small wood dowels (part #2), cam locks (part #15) and phillips head screwdriver.

Note: Cam locks must rotate a full 180°. See pictured insert.



Step 5. Attach fixed shelf (part E3) and rail (part F2) to left panel (part B2) using large wood dowels (part #1), cam locks (part #15) and phillips head screwdriver.

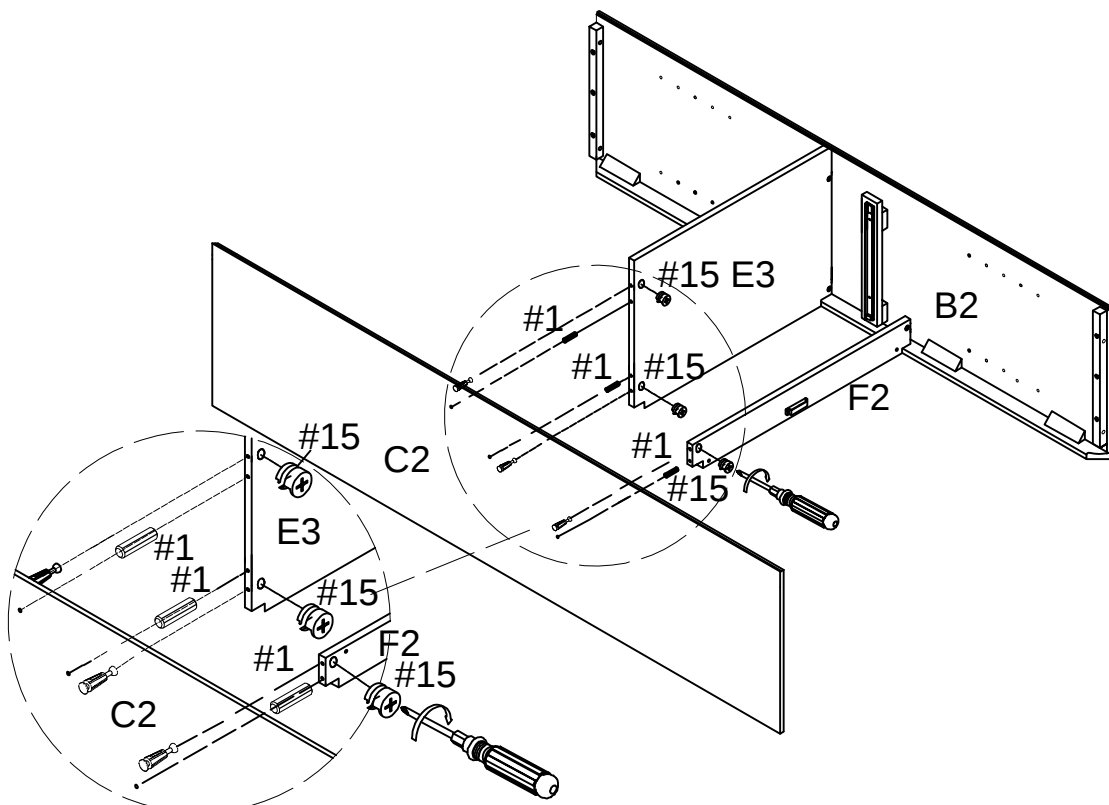

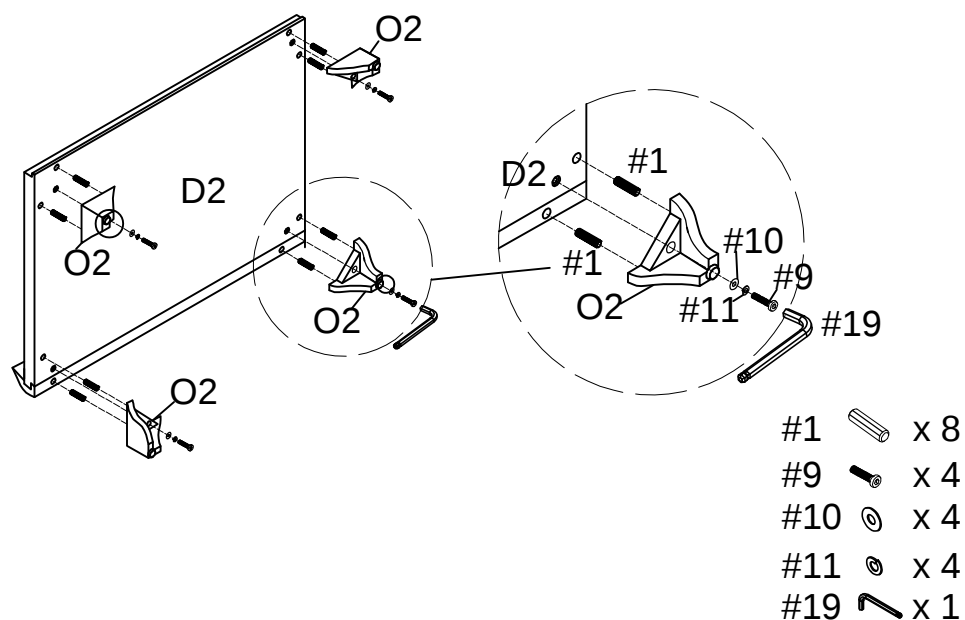
Step 6. Attach right panel (part C2) to fixed shelf (part E3) and rail (part F2) using large wood dowels (part #1), cam locks (part #15) and phillips head screwdriver.

Note: Cam locks must rotate a full 180°. See pictured insert.

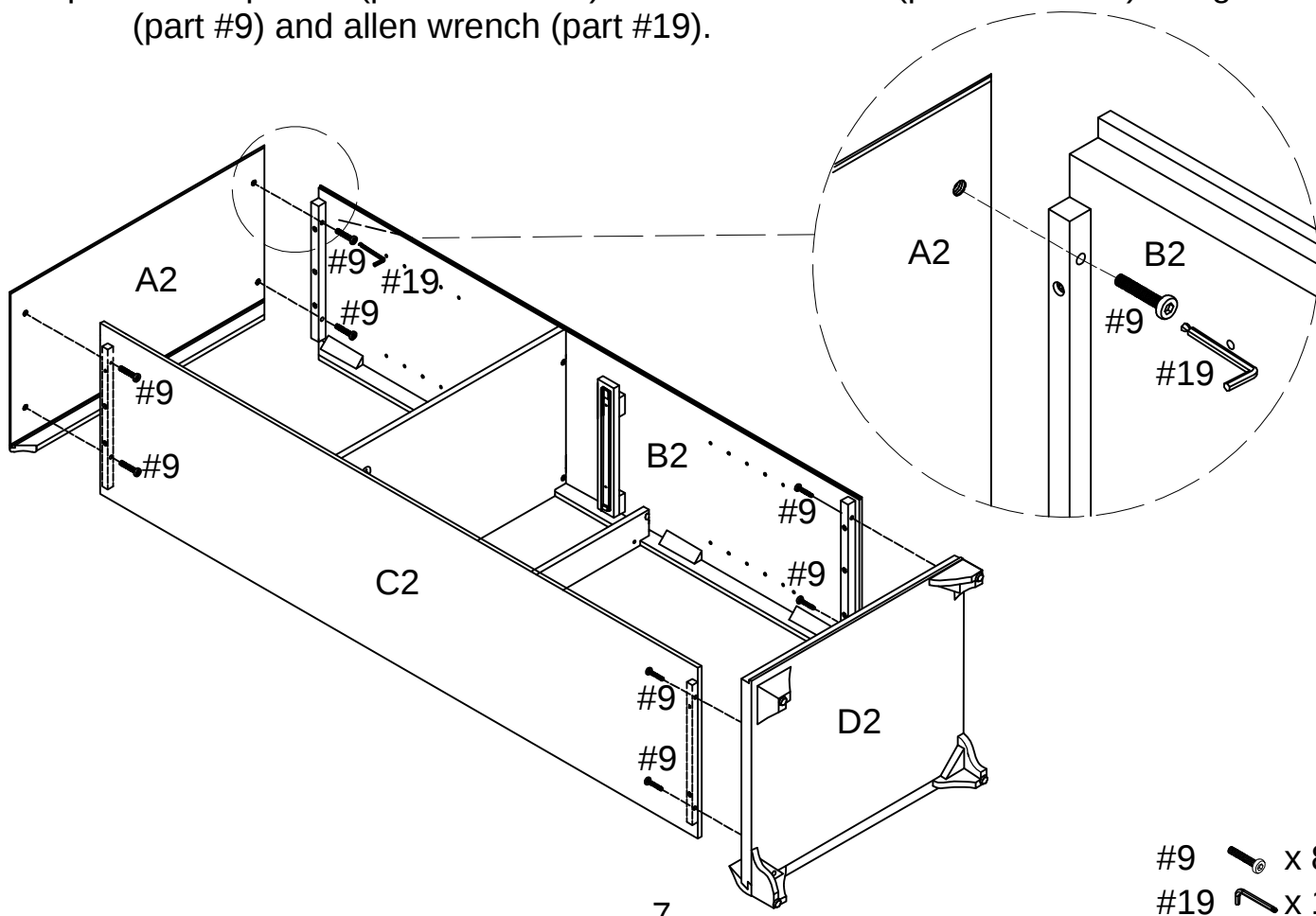

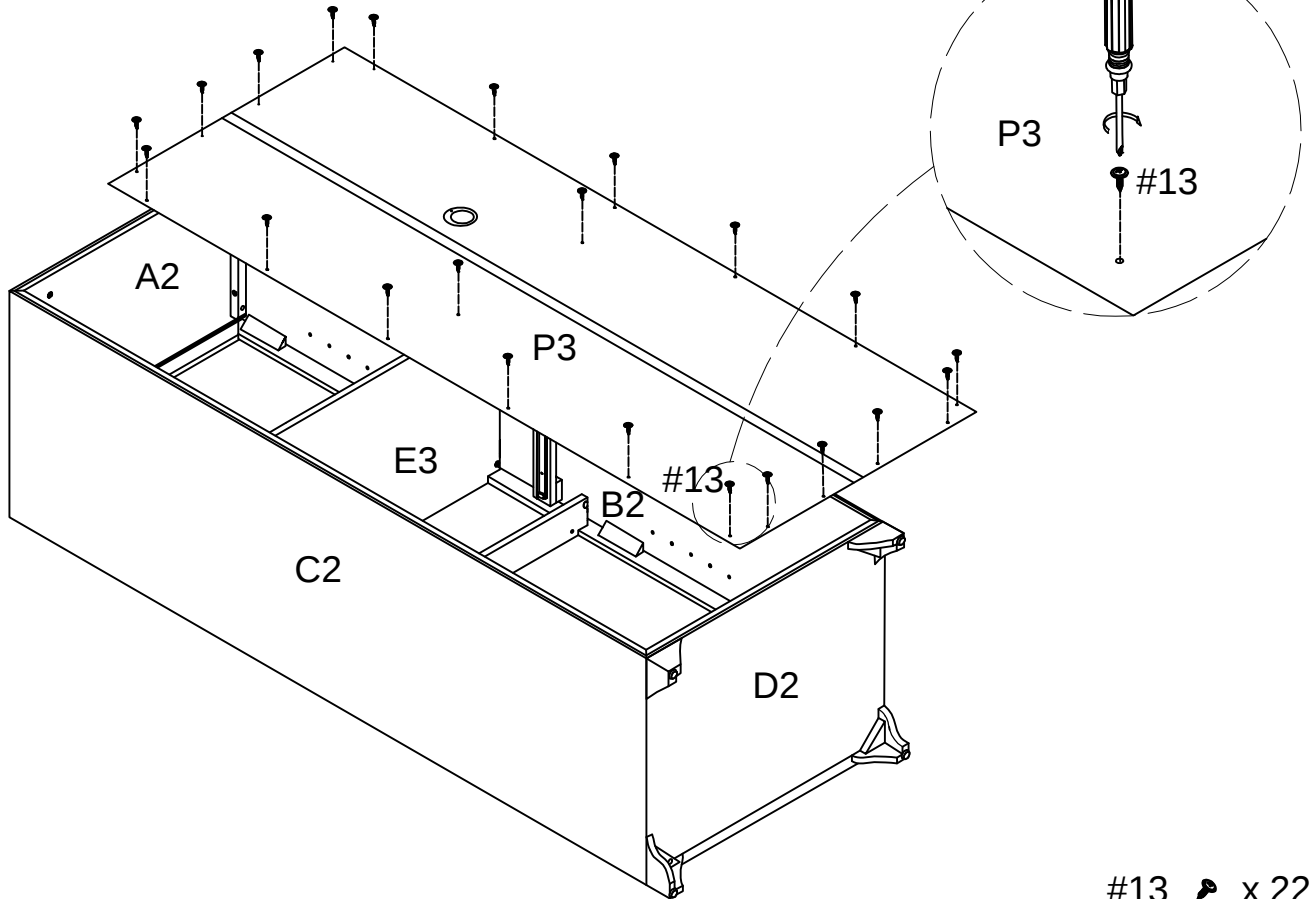
Step 7. Attach legs (part O2) to bottom panel (part D2) using large wood dowels (part #1), bolts (part #9), flat washers (part #10), spring washers (part #11) and allen wrench (part #19).



Step 8. Attach panels (parts A2 & D2) to assembled unit (parts B2 & C2) using bolts (part #9) and allen wrench (part #19).



Step 9. Attach back panel (part P3) to assembled unit (parts A2, B2, C2, D2 & E3) using screws (part #13) and phillips head screwdriver.

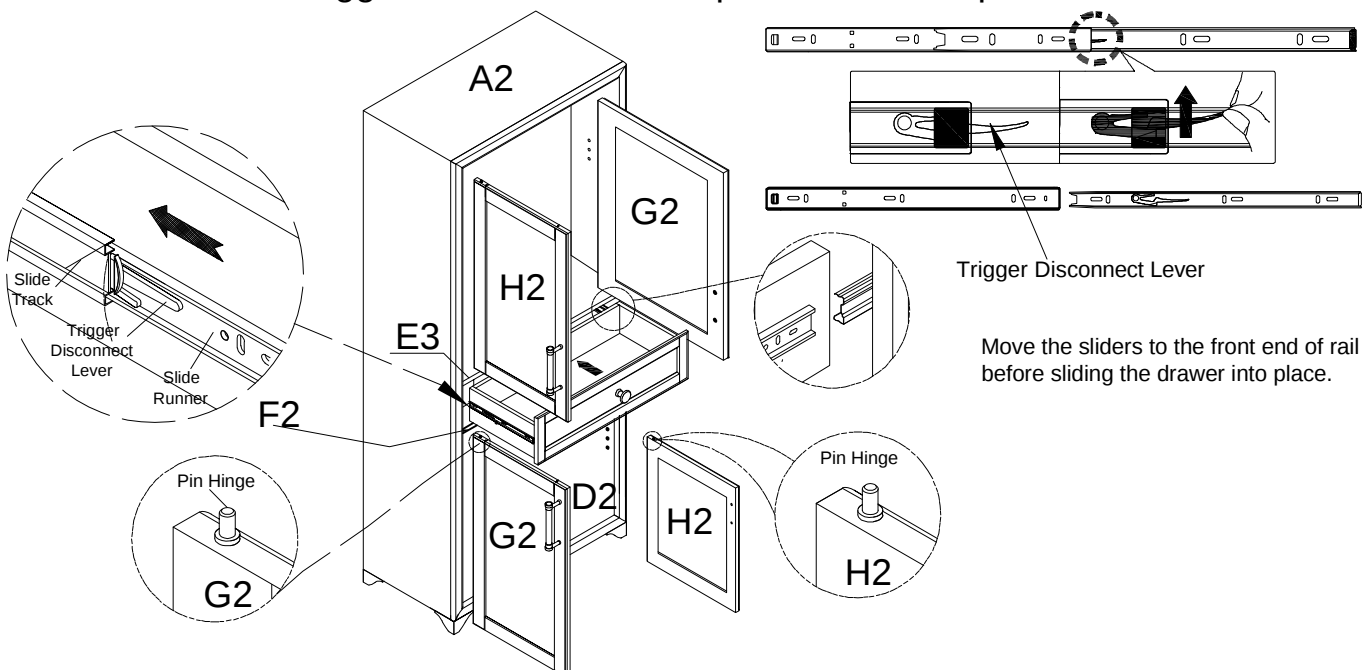


Step 10. Carefully turn unit upright. Slide assembled drawer into place.

Attach doors (parts G2 & H2) by placing bottom pin hinge (pre-installed in door) in the pre-drilled hole of bottom panel (part D2) and fixed shelf (part E3). Then depress the top spring-loaded pin hinge so it can be placed in the pre-drilled hole of rail (part F2) and top panel (part A2).

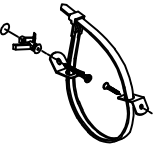
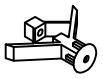
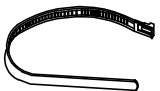
Note: Be sure top and bottom pin hinges are fully extended to secure door in place.

Note: To release trigger disconnect levers push one side up and the other down.



Note: It is important to adjust levelers once fully assembled and upright. Extend adjustable leveler until it's firmly in contact with the floor. If relocating, adjust leveler as needed until it's firmly in contact with the floor in new location.



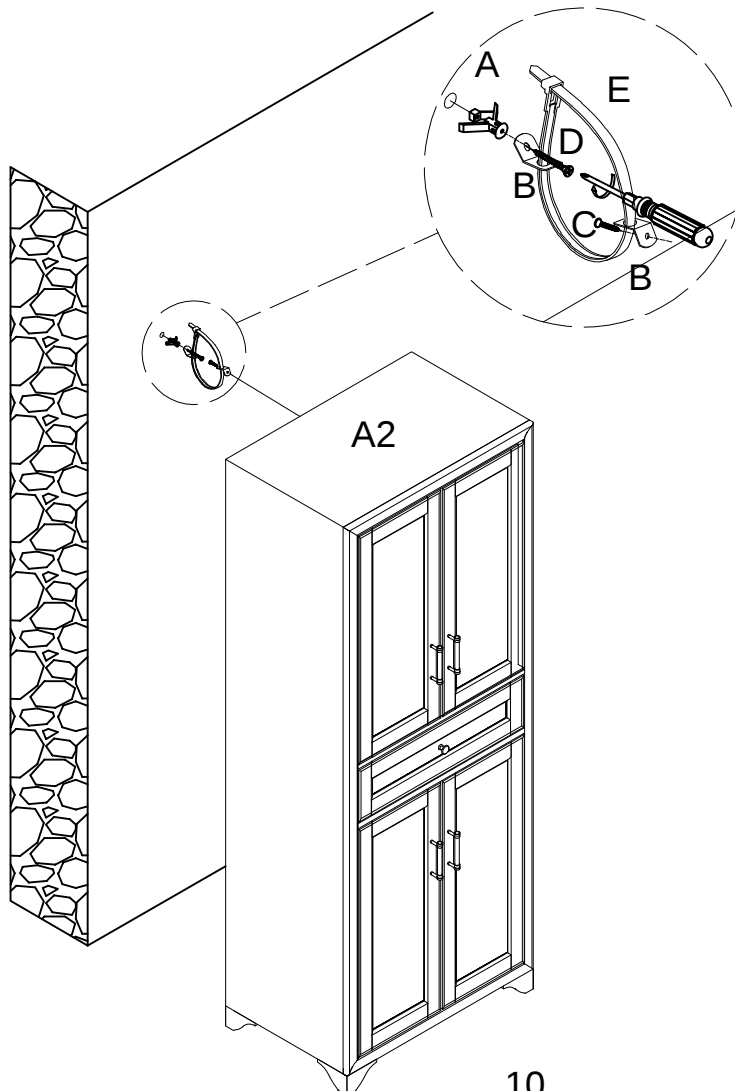

SAFETY WALL STRAP INSTALLATION

Note: It is highly recommended to install this safety strap kit to prevent tipping, damage and/or injury.

1. Insert short screw (C) and safety wall strap (E) through bracket (B) and attach to top panel (part A2) using phillips head screwdriver.
2. Drill a 11/32" hole where you want to secure the unit. The drilled hole will be at the same height as the hole in top panel (part A2) where bracket (B) is attached. Tap wall anchor (A) into the hole.
3. Insert long screw (D) and safety wall strap (E) through bracket (B) into wall anchor (A) using phillips head screwdriver.

Note: This item is not intended for clothing storage use.
