Why are we helping?

- · Food assistance programs focus solely on food and nutrition and don't cover diapers
- Babies kept in dirty diapers for extended periods of time may lead to babies suffering not just physically but emotionally
- The majority of licensed day care centers require a full day's supply of disposable diapers and most Laundromats do not allow cloth diapers for sanitary reasons.
