From the Driver's Seat - Harvey Yancey, President



A Time for Change and Continuity

This morning Bob Saville and I had our regular bagel and coffee at Einstein's over on South Blvd. (we do this a couple times a week) but I could tell Bob had something on his mind today. I knew that the Board was in the process of making their final decision as to who of the three candidates would be taking over the Presidency from Bob. I was guessing that the decision had been made although I wasn't sure. Bob is a good poker player or at least that's what he keeps telling me. But today he definitely was keeping his cards close to his vest as he simply wasn't letting anything on.

Part of me was hoping that Dale Hewitt or Jerry Kilcrease had gotten the nod by the Board. Both are dedicated PCA members, have a log track record with the Region and well deserving of the position. Either would be great choices for President. The other part of me was ready to get re-engaged with the Club in an official capacity. Since Parade came to an end in July I have kept somewhat busy tying up loose ends associated with that event (btw – we made about \$25K on Parade as a Region). However, after having transitioned the Membership Chair position to Nadine Saville back in 2007 and more recently handing the reins of Website Management to Paul Lueskow, I no longer had a job within the club.

Bob finally segued into a discussion about the vote. He spent quite some time going over the steps that the Board had taken during its' deliberations and decision making process. A lot of questions were asked. It was a very thorough vetting and I was quite amazed at some of the factors that they had taken into account.

Bob said the vote had been very close but then asked "So are you ready to do this?" I think my response was something like "Do I have a choice now?"

So here we are.

For those of you that do not know me personally I think it is appropriate for me to share a bit about myself and my background with the Club. I am a native North Carolinian (born in New Bern). I graduated from UNC-Chapel Hill

with a Political Science degree and have been involved the computer industry since graduation. I have worked for Microsoft since 1990 and I also own a restaurant business in Charlotte. I married the former Vivian Willoughby in 2001. We have two bulldogs named Beau and Sadie that provide non-stop home entertainment.

I joined PCA in 1995 right after I bought my first Porsche, a 1973 911T (a future column may be dedicated to that car and my experiences as an overanxious first time buyer). The Metrolina Area at the time was dormant. As a new PCA member I was very disappointed by that and felt that something needed to be done. I along with Mike Rich, Blaine DeLancey and a few others started meeting at H. Dundee's Steakhouse over on Independence Blvd., here in Charlotte. One by one members started to trickle in over the next year or so. Then Chuck Zachman and Tina Angelichio (now Zachman) showed up and everything started to heat up. Chuck took over as Area Director from me and eventually became Regional President (1999). But Chuck and Tina's legacy was the development of PorscheFest, our region's first Multi-Event weekend starting in 1997. Not only was it a hit, but unbeknownst to us at the time, it laid the foundation for our hosting of Porsche Parade this past year.

Other people that have highly influence this Regions' rise were Past Presidents Cliff Hudgins (1996-1997) and Gary Bumgardner (1998). Both have been friends and mentors to me to this day.

Since joining the Club I have served as Metrolina Area Director, Regional Web Manager, Regional Vice President, Regional Membership Chair, National Driver's Ed Instructor and most recently as the Chair for Porsche Parade 2008. In addition to the above PCA positions I was one of the founders of the the Blue Ridge Boxster Summit and I served on the Board of the EURO Auto Festival. And yes, believe it or not, I do have a life outside of the Club!

Now that you know a little bit about who I am, you may ask ... "Where do we as a Club go from here?"

The Carolinas Region currently is in great shape. We are organized, motivated and well funded. After Parade, we are now clearly on everyone's radar. People know who we are, what we can do and what we are all about. We are recognized as a leader not only in Zone 3 but across the nation. By the numbers we are one of the largest Regions

in the country, currently 7th, which not only gives us great diversity in numbers and interests but allows us to put on a lot of great events.

But as with any organization we simply cannot become complacent and rest on past accomplishments. We need to continue to grow, to be organized and focused.

Bob and I share very similar philosophies when it comes to the Club and the Region. Namely that we provide quality events that our members want to attend, get people involved and above all have fun. As President Bob did an outstanding job promoting those tenets and I intend to do the same.

On my watch we will continue with our traditional events (Fall Tour, PorscheFest, Driver's Ed, Spring & Fall AutoFair, EURO), enhance newer events (Autocross Series) and look at adding others. We have an extensive schedule now but if something makes sense it will be considered. For example we are in discussions to do an event in conjunction with TRG (yeah, those guys) in 2009.

There are a few open positions that we need to fill on the Board and there are other positions that we will be adding to give us more depth and capabilities (if you are interested in a position please contact me directly). One new addition as of December is Mike Jones as our Regional Concours Chair. He has basically been doing this job for several years and an official position is deserved. Congrats Mike! BTW –

Additionally one of my goals will be to develop a system in which we grow and develop our members for Area and Regional positions. That way we have a clear line of succession that ensures stability and continuity for the Region.

A big goal for us all in 2009 is to foster more member participation. As with any club or similar organization you typically have a core group of about 10-15% or so of the membership that gets involved. This is true with our Region. Many members simply joined the club to get PANORAMA and Tobacco Roads, which is perfectly ok. But for me that is sort of like going to a great restaurant and then only eating the bread.

So if you have not attended an Area Meeting, please make it a point to go to at least one meeting in January or February to see what this Club is all about. This past year at Metrolina Area Meetings we had several people that had been PCA members for years but had never come to a meeting before. Now they are regular attendees and have

been to several events. If you have been coming to meetings but have not attended an event, look at the Regional Calendar and pick something. Go to a Driver's Ed or an Autocross if only to watch the action. Trust me the participants love spectators as do our sponsors. Our Region provides a lot of options whether your interests are track, tours, autocross, Concours or if you just want to hang out and chat with like-minded gearheads. You just need to get out there and take advantage of it.

There are other ideas and plans that I will share with the Board and the membership at large over the next few months. Many of those ideas have come from conversations with you: the members of this Region. I will always have an 'Open Door' policy and I welcome your ideas on how to make the Region and the Club better. Let me know your thoughts!

Before I close I must plug an excellent upcoming event. That event is our Mid-Winter Track Seminar to be held on Jan 31st at Carolina Motorsports Park in Kershaw SC. If you have ever wanted to participate in a Driver's Ed or thought about driving your car on a track and are curious about the specifics, then plan to go. The classroom instruction is first rate and even if you never drive your car on the track you will gain valuable insight on that will make you a better driver. Best of all it's **FREE** and lunch will be provided. You can't get any better than that!

We wish Bob all the best in his new role as Zone 3 Rep. If he does half as good a job in this role as he did as Regional President the Zone will be in great shape. I am personally looking forward to working with and for you in 2009; and please remember: this is **YOUR** club ... so get involved!

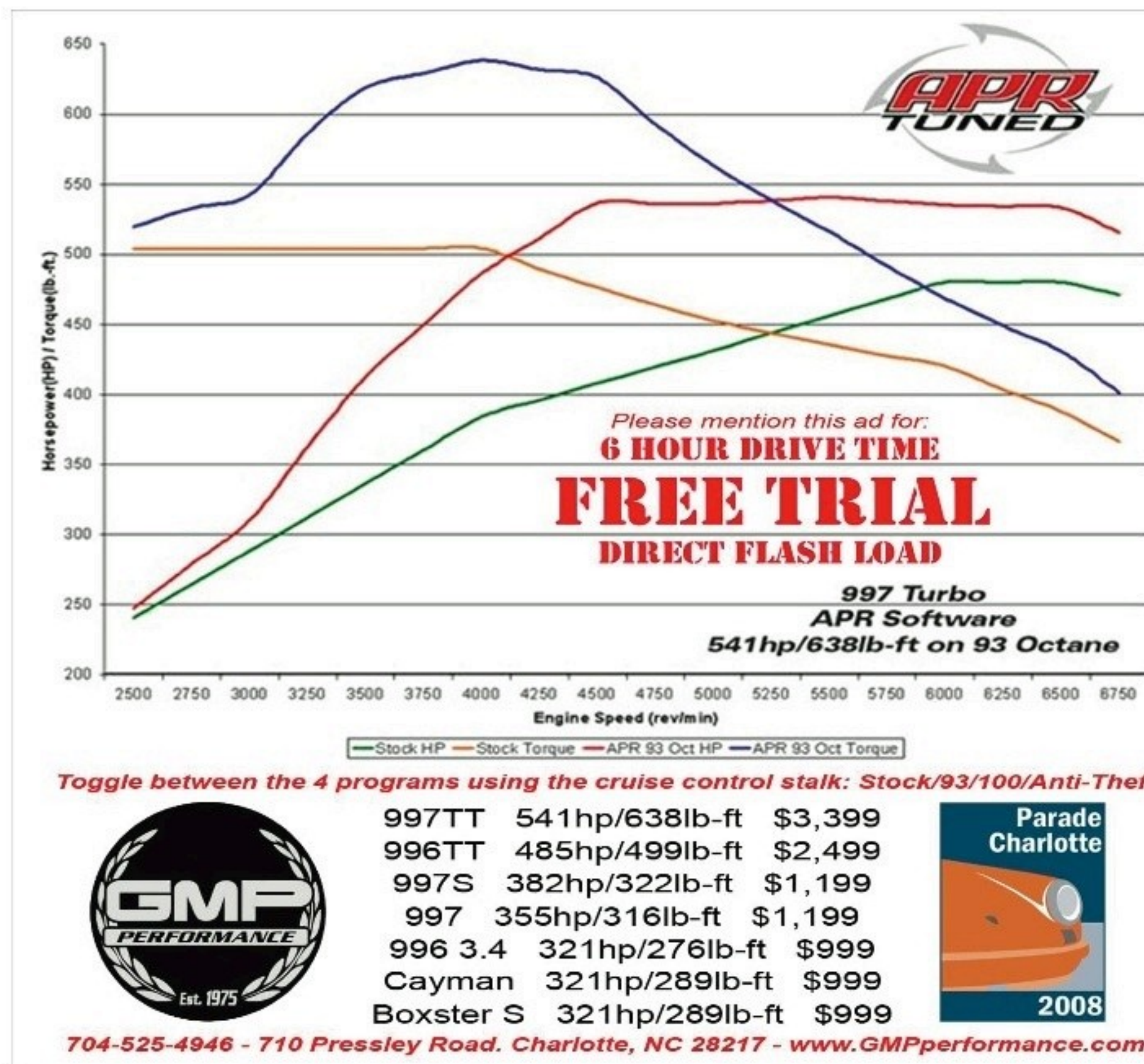

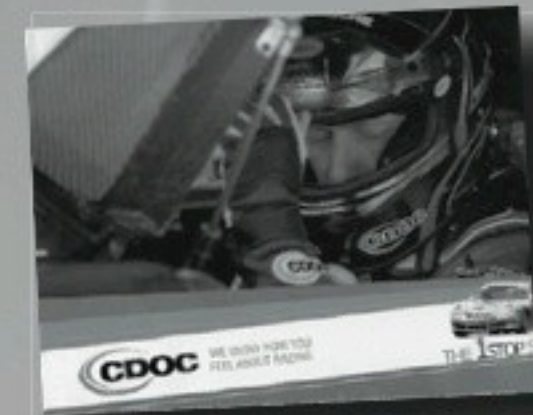
