

# **Driver Education:**

Greetings and salutations my extended Carolinas Region family! As some of you may know, I have taken on the role of Driver Education chair for our region, giving John the freedom he needs to realize some well earned retirement plans. It has been a pleasure being a participant, then later an instructor, and now the chair for the DE program. Sitting down to write this article I am struck by my lack of experience in the endeavor, but here goes!!

If you've not participated in a DE event and want to learn more about you, your car, and what you can do together, I encourage you to come participate! When I got connected with our DE program through a work friend, I did not even own a Porsche and brought my 2006 Infiniti G35 sedan. I realized very quickly that while I understood how to navigate the public roadway in a safe manner, I had no idea about the capabilities of my car or how to drive it when things became interesting. This simply should not be pursued on public roads.

After my first event, I chose to pursue the purchase of my first Porsche, which turned out to be a 1987 944 Turbo of questionable provenance. There is a story there too long for this article, so if you come to an event feel free to ask. It turned out that learning to drive properly was a more daunting task than I had initially thought. What made it possible was the caliber of instructors our region has available. The depth of knowledge, experience, ability to adapt, and especially patience, kept me involved and ultimately led me to join those instructor ranks. Each instructor brought a new perspective while also meeting me where I was in skill and goals. When PCA says "It's not just the cars, it's the people", that includes our DE program, and is what kept me coming back to PCA events both within and outside of our region.

Your journey to a full and immersive automotive experience can be started this September the 7th and 8th at Carolina Motorsports Park in Kershaw SC. Registration is open on www.clubregistration.net as of July 8, and we would love to have you come join all of us in continuing to learn to drive. We once again have HBi Auto as our sponsor. HBI Auto is your dealership alternative for service, repair, fabrication, performance, and track preparation of all Porsches as well as all other makes and models. As a reminder for the veterans of the DE program on HANS requirements, PCA National requires the use of a HANS whenever 5 or 6 point harnesses are used, for both passenger and driver. For those with OEM seatbelt equipped cars there is no change (unless it came from the factory with harnesses and you plan to use them). From a safety standpoint this only makes sense to ensure a complete system of protection and to comply with equal restraint rules already in place. I've attached a YOUTUBE clip showing the difference between a driver with harness but no HANS versus his navigator who is wearing a HANS device. While the harness keeps the driver from moving you can clearly see the extended movements of his head which can cause life threatening basilar skull fractures (BSF).




