



- 3) You must provide your current PCA membership number when submitting a classified ad.

- 5) No commercial ads. All commercial ads must be purchased. Contact TR Editor for pricing.
- 6) Ads will run for two months. If the item is not sold within that time frame the seller will need to contact the Editor at






The Club Needs Your HELP!

Porsches at the Palace: A Winter Tour Michael Vittorio, Hickory Area Director

The Hickory Area of the Carolinas Region PCA conducted its Winter Tour on March 5 thru 8, 2020. New Bern, NC was the destination.

New Bern is one of the most charming small towns in the Southeast. Situated as it is at the confluence of the Trent and Neuse Rivers, the city was a major port and trading center in the 1700 and 1800s. At one time the largest city in NC, New Bern became the first permanent seat of the colonial government of North Carolina and was, for a time, the state capital. Along with the reconstructed Tryon Palace (home of NC's colonial governor) and gardens, more than 164 homes and buildings listed on the National Register have been beautifully restored and provide much of the charm that is present day New Bern. In addition, several bed and breakfasts, hotels, restaurants, banks, antiques stores and specialty shops can be found within easy walking distance of the waterfront.

Such was the backdrop for our Winter Tour.

The Tour was organized by Carolinas Region Members Bryson and Kathy Kiser and sponsored by Porsche of Hickory. Forty-three PCA Members from the Carolinas and Hurricane Regions participated. The Tour began on Thursday when participants gathered at the Porsche of Hickory dealership for a complimentary light breakfast and drivers meeting. Due to the distance to our destination, we traveled mostly on highways with personal stops and a lunch break (where we were joined by the rest of our group) along the way.

A side note: Keith and Donna Antal, driving their 227,000 mile, 1992 Porsche 964, encountered some engine trouble along the way. Following a brief call to our contact at Porsche Hickory, it was arranged for Keith to stop at sister dealership Porsche of Greensboro where an air-cooled specialist awaited their arrival. Keith was able to "nurse" the car to the dealership where the problem was quickly diagnosed and parts ordered. Meanwhile, Keith and Donna rented a car and joined the festivities in New Bern. Their Porsche was repaired by Saturday at which time Keith and Donna retrieved it. Thanks to great service by our friends at Porsche Hickory and Porsche Greensboro, Keith and Donna were able to enjoy the Tour and drive their Porsche back home without a hitch.

Upon arrival in New Bern, we all checked into the Marriott Courtyard Inn where most of us were provided water front rooms ... and Happy Hour began. The Marriott has a large open space that accommodated all of us for social time and an adult beverage prior to dinner. A little later we traveled a short distance to The Chelsea restaurant. We gathered for cock-tails and dinner in a private upstairs dining room where we were served a banquet style dinner consisting of southern style delicacies. Following dinner, we all returned once again to the Marriott for some social time and a night cap.





Friday was set aside for participants to enjoy one of several area drives charted by Kathy and Bryson. Routes to Beaufort, Moorhead City, Bath and other towns in the area were all self-guided options. In addition, local resident/Hurricane Region Member Dexter Liu, led a drive to Oriental, NC for lunch and a stop at a favoriate ice cream parlor.

Upon return from their chosen excursion, folks gathered at the hotel for drinks and some social time. Dinner was "on your own" so several small groups formed and enjoyed their choice of dining venue.

Saturday was our day to explore and enjoy the many charms of New Bern proper, starting with a visit to Tryon Palace one of the truly unique aspects of this trip. Not only did we enjoy an excellent guided tour of the home (Palace) and gardens, we were also afforded the opportunity to display our cars at the front entrance to the property – so far as we know, a first. Apparently, when approached about the visit of so many PCA members and their cars, the management of Tryon Palace recognized this as a great potential marketing tool. The opportunity to view so many Porsches on display was seen as an additional incentive to purchase a ticket to tour the Palace and gardens.
