





Starting in 1497 the natives were joined by the Scottish, Irish, English & Acadians (descendants of the French), all contributing to the Gaelic melange. I plan to take the cliff-hanging, anti-clockwise route offering the best views. (However, my bride of 51 years is not interested to travel for so long & far in a small car.)

Nova Scotia's notoriously inhospitable Bay of Fundy is home of the world's highest & most powerful tidal surges with more than 160 billion tons of water flowing in & out of the bay daily. This tidal energy resource contains more than four times the combined flow of every freshwater river in the world. In addition to creating the TVA when seeking more electricity to power the arsenal of democracy in WW2, FDR initiated efforts to harness this renewable, kinetic, tidal energy. Tremendous technical & cost challenges are still to be solved; however, current collaborations among America, Canada, England & Germany have renewed promise for success. With water 830 times more dense than air, and the tides flowing nonstop 24/7/365 for "free," the potential for renewable, tidal, electric energy worldwide is game changing. My trip will include a visit to the Fundy Ocean Research Center for Energy (FORCE) in the Minas Passage, Bay of Fundy about 10 km west of Parrsboro, Nova Scotia.





President's Project Page

"Promise Kept-40 Years Strong"

I continue sharing YOUR Story, YOUR Passion for your Porsche(s) from around the Region. Many thanks to those that have stepped up and shared with all of us, here in the President's Project Page. This month I bring to you a promise story; including Datsun trade-in, Hair-Dryers and Snow Plows...40 years strong!

Please ENJOY!

My very first car was a 1969 GTO 4-speed, with my second a stylish little Datsun 240Z which I had for some time. Fast forward to college and I had always told myself that when I graduate Chiropractic School, I would drive a Porsche. Graduating in 1983 saw me going to Legend Porsche in Brooklyn, NY and ordering my very own 1983 Porsche 911 SC Coupe, triple black, sunroof, 3.0 L, 5-speed and a whale tail, (yes, you could order a whale tail back in the day - I have the paperwork with option 473 to prove it).



Back in The Day!

At the time I went to take delivery of my new Porsche I had decided to trade in my 240Z. I recall telling the salesman "I will miss my Datsun" and vividly remember his response of "not when you drive this". Nothing could have proven to be truer. At that time, the Porsche was my only means of transportation to my business in Long Island, NY from my home on the North Shore of Long Island.

I had lived on an estate there with the Porsche safely kept; although it had never been garaged at that time and was driven in the rain, snow, sun, for work, shopping and going out. At times I would put a car cover on it to help protect it. There was one winter night it had rained and then

the temperature dropped so much that the car cover had frozen. That morning when it was time for me to get to work the car cover would not come off. I did not want to pull the paint off the Porsche, so I got my hair dryer from the house with a long extension cord and 2 hours later I had melted all the ice and off to work I drove.

About 1987 I had a custom home built on the North Shore of Long Island, this time with a 2-car garage (unfortunately this also came with a very steep and long driveway). Funny story, but with the driveway being so long and steep, getting the trash to the street was a huge task, so I would put the trash bags on the whale tail and drive down to the curb, drop them off, and then head on to work. During the New York winters it was difficult to get the Porsche up the icy driveway, so I bought a Jeep Wrangler with a plow painted to match the Jeep. I would use it to plow my driveway as well as my office parking lot.

For many years, when the weather was nice, I used the Porsche as my daily "going to work" car. In 1997 I moved up to Westchester NY, where I kept the Porsche in the garage, but still used it for work. In 2000 I met my husband Thomas who owned a noted restoration facility and took pride in taking care of the Porsche with me as well as some of his muscle cars.

About 2001 I began limiting the use of the Porsche with us going to local Concours events in Connecticut and Long Island. We would go to Americana Concours, Driven to America-Tribute to Max Hoffman, Great Marques-Old Westbury Gardens to name a few; always taking an award in the original/unrestored class and getting offers from attendees to purchase the car.






