"Tobacco Roads - Turning the Page, Digitally"

This month, I will utilize this space for a very important topic as it relates to the future of Tobacco Roads. We as the Carolinas Region Board of Directors (The Board) understand and share YOUR Passion for our Tobacco Roads Newsletter. It is deeply engrained into the fabric of our great Region since 1969 – AND WILL REMAIN. Please read on to see our announcement:

History:

The Carolinas Region was formed in December of 1961 and our original communication to our members was in the form of a literal interpretation of the word newsletter named *Frohe Fahrt Mit P.C.A. Carolinas*. This format was used until 1964, when it was changed to the *Carolinas News Letter*. This was the first time a multiple stapled magazine type of newsletter was used; this ended in 1968. The end of the *Carolinas News Letter* was only the beginning of what we know today as *Tobacco Roads* for 1969.

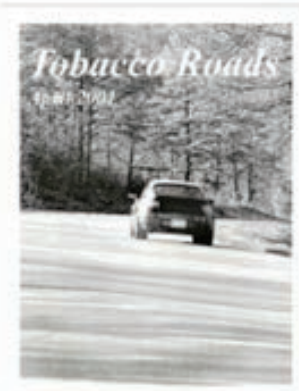
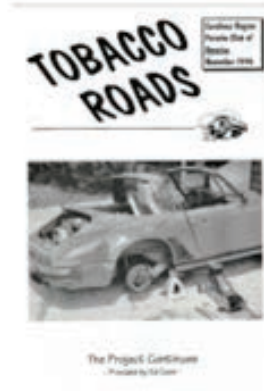

The Facts/Costs to Distribute:

- Nothing in our Strategic Planning for Tobacco Roads should be construed as a proposal to discontinue publication of the newsletter. Rather, our intent was to explore whether our current methods of publication and distribution are an efficient use of Club funds.
- Tobacco Roads production is the Carolinas Regions single largest annual unfunded expense. Though supported in part by advertising revenue, the net cost of publishing Tobacco Roads in 2021 was \$15,109 and in 2022 it increased to \$25,506.
- Despite attempts to control these costs, they continue to rise and will likely do so in the future as Printing costs (ink, collation, paper, mailing) have risen accordingly.
- The Board has conducted numerous SurveyMonkey attempts to best gauge what we should do with Tobacco Roads. This has been rather inconclusive as traditionally; we have received 13-17% participation in these surveys. Perhaps some small indication can be found in the results of an informal survey conducted by the Director of one of our larger Areas. Though based on a small sample size, 96% of respondents indicated a preference for electronic vs printed version.
- Carolinas Region is one of the very few Regions still paying for the publication of a printed monthly newsletter. Throughout our fellow Zone 3 Regions, the other 15 Regions publish and distribute their newsletters primarily via electronic means. One of these Regions, however, does publish a quarterly printed edition as a special supplement to their other means of communicating with members.
- An electronic/digital version of Tobacco Roads would provide capabilities that a printed version does not. E.g., hyperlinks embedded in an electronic version can take readers directly to event registration web sites and those of our advertisers.

Principal Action Steps:

The following actions as it relates to Tobacco Roads were voted on and approved by The Board on March 16, 2023:

1. Beginning with the July 2023 edition of Tobacco Roads (and until such time that The Board adopts an alternate strategy) the newsletter will be published and distributed digitally. The Carolinas Region will no longer fund production of hard copy versions of the newsletter for distribution to Members or advertisers/sponsors. Alternatively, a .pdf file and/or link to an electronic version of Tobacco Roads will be emailed to all Members (Primary and Associate).

2. Multiple avenues of communication will be utilized over time to provide all Carolinas Region PCA Members with a clear and accurate understanding of why Carolinas Region is transitioning to digital production/distribution of its newsletter, how and when this transition will take place and how said transition will ultimately benefit its' Members.

Communication plan is as follows:

a. April – Tobacco Roads article from the President to all members to include an email “blast” from the President to ALL Members once again aligning on the message.

b. May – President publishes communication of the plan in the months issue of Tobacco Roads.

c. June – A further reminder is published in the months issue of the newsletter reminding Members that this will be the last hard copy edition of Tobacco Roads, reiterating why, noting that money previously spent on hard copy publication/distribution will be reallocated to enhance/offer other Member activities, and how to access the electronic version.

Any monetary savings resulting from cessation of printed newsletters will be reallocated to fund activities - at both the Regional and Area level - that benefit YOU, our members.

Area Directors will have access to funds by submitting their annual budgets at the beginning of the year as well as additional proposals and event specific budgets can be submitted to The Board for approval at any time during the fiscal year - dependent, of course, on the availability of funds.

The Board will continue to review all available communication tools to assure the Carolinas Region takes full advantage of opportunities to enhance communications with our members.

As you can read, we have taken much deliberation, discussion and strategic thought into the future of Tobacco Roads in order to PRESERVE, PROTECT and continue to PUBLISH this newsletter well into the next six decades. Digital forms will ensure more clarity of photos, embedded videos, usable links that will immediately take You, the member to registration of events, etc....
