## CORRECTION

The AX\#1 report published in TR last month had some timing errors and some cars were in the wrong class when registered. I have audited the times against our manual logs we use as backup in case the timing equipment or the timekeeper misses something.

As a result, I have edited 8 classes to move the car into the proper class per the PCA national classes. I also filled in some of the times in the later runs that were missing and that changed 3 trophy positions.

The points standings were also corrected to align with the class changes and run time corrections.
In the AX\#1 timing report I have highlighted the BEST times that were changed, and the results of those changes changed 3 trophy positions - noted to the side in RED. The trophies for those that changed will be available at the next AX event. The 2023 points report was also updated to correspond to the changes to the timing report.

Going forward I will monitor the classes in Clubregistration.net and correct any that are incorrect. We will also do a final check during the technical inspections to note anything that may cause a last-minute class change. We will be looking for cars classed in the STOCK class that should be in PRODUCTION classes (modifications that would move the car up to $P$ classes or higher.) Cars that are Stock or Production that are running RACE tires (i.e. Hoosiers) will be moved to M classes. The minimum tire wear rating to stay in S or P class is 200 . Cars running higher tire wear i.e. 320 or 500 series will still compete with 200 TW tires.

STOCK classes are for cars as they came off the assembly line. Modifications that will move a car in to PRODUCTION or higher classes would be things like - changes to exhaust, intake, wheel size, suspension, engine modifications, transmission modifications, etc.

The Carolinas Region will no longer fund production of hard copy versions of the newsletter for distribution to Members or advertisers/sponsors. Alternatively, a .pdf file and/or link to an electronic version of Tobacco Roads will be emailed to all Members (Primary and Associate).
*You must login to your PCA Membership account and enable receiving emails from the Region. See steps provided at the end of this article for the "how to".
2. Multiple avenues of communication will be utilized over time to provide all Carolinas Region PCA Members with a clear and accurate understanding of why Carolinas Region is transitioning to digital production/ distribution of its newsletter, how and when this transition will take place and how said transition will ultimately benefit its' Members.

## Communication plan is as follows:

a. April - Tobacco Roads article from the President to all members to include an email "blast" from the President to ALL Members once again aligning on the message. (DONE)
b. May - President publishes communication of the plan in the months issue of Tobacco Roads. (DONE) c. June - A further reminder is published in the months issue of the newsletter reminding Members that this will be the last hard copy edition of Tobacco Roads, reiterating why, noting that money previously spent on hard copy publication/distribution will be reallocated to enhance/offer other Member activities, and how to access the electronic version. (DONE)

Any monetary savings resulting from cessation of printed newsletters will be reallocated to fund activities - at both the Regional and Area level - that benefit YOU, our members.
Area Directors will have access to funds by submitting their annual budgets at the beginning of the year as well as additional proposals and event specific budgets can be submitted to The Board for approval at any time during the fiscal year - dependent, of course, on the availability of funds.
