In response to the many questions we have received about the recent Porsche Hickory closure, I share Michael Vittorio's Hickory Area announcement:

Porsche Hickory is no more. Earlier this month we received notification that Porsche Hickory has closed its doors. As of July 1, the Hickory dealership has merged with Porsche Greensboro. Thus, there is no longer a certified Porsche Sales or Service facility in Hickory. These changes are reportedly the result of Porsche Cars North America's requirement that Paramount Automotive (their parent company) build new, stand-alone Sales and Service facilities at their Porsche dealerships in both Greensboro and Hickory. Given Porsche Hickory's sales volume, a good business case could not be made for doing so in Hickory. Thus, Paramount has relinquished their Hickory Porsche franchise.

Though we in Hickory regret the loss of our local Porsche dealership, the overall impact is not as bad as feared. In fact, in many ways, little will change.

- Porsche Hickory has merged with Porsche Greensboro. The Hickory Porsche showroom will be re-purposed and a new Porsche dealership will be constructed in Greensboro.
- All sales of new Porsche automobiles will be done through Porsche Greensboro. However, Bob Smith, Zach Pletcher and others will continue to be available in Hickory to facilitate the sale and make it as seamless as possible for Hickory area customers.
- All factory allocations for new Porsche vehicles previously allotted to the Hickory dealership have been combined with those from Greensboro. This results in the availability of much larger selection of new vehicles from which you can choose.
- What was previously the Porsche Hickory dealership will become Foreign Cars Europa, an outlet for pre-owned luxury automobiles including Porsche and other comparable brands. Caleb Pletcher is returning to Hickory as sales manager.
- All factory warranty service will be done at Porsche Greensboro. Hickory service staff will facilitate this work including transporting your car to/from Porsche Greensboro.
- Hickory's factory trained technicians will continue to provide non-warranty service for your Porsche at Foreign Cars Europa. Brent Huffman will continue as Service Manager.

And.

 For the remainder of this year and perhaps next, our Hickory Area Porsche club will continue to receive the same level of support we have enjoyed for many years.

So, though we will no longer be able to see and purchase a new Porsche from a Hickory showroom, Paramount leadership has pledged to minimize any disruption this may cause and to continue to provide a high level of sales and service support for Hickory area Porsche customers.

This event did delay our sign-up for the Fall Tour.




