


Spring has sprung, so lets get out & drive!!!



Why would we do this?



Forming a new Upstate SC Region would provide the new region with financial resources required to hold more of the events that our members desire. Membership dues rebates would come directly to our new region, funds would be directed to these member interests, surplus funds would remain in the new region treasury, plus we could apply for and receive PCA rebates and subsidies for activities and events and be eligible for PCA bonus rebates.

Summarizing the information above, the benefits of forming a new Upstate SC region are as follows;

- Its governance will be in closer touch to the wants and needs of its membership, with more consistent communications due to its leadership being local.
- Significantly more involvement by local members in the planning and executing of local PCA events.
- Improved financial resources to hold more of the PCA events that the membership desires, while its membership would still be able to attend PCA events offered by other PCA regions, such as HPDE or Auto-X .
- Improved financial resources to try new events proposed by its members, thus creating an exciting club experience. The new region would also be eligible for PCA event subsidies. This all leads to a healthy region that retains current members and draws new members.
- Better Upstate member representation and participation at the Zone & National levels. An Upstate Region would be represented at PCA Zone 3 meetings.

We recognize that many Upstate area members have made great friendships with members of other areas within the Carolinas Region at region-wide activities such as Spring and Fall Tours. Please remember, as a member of PCA you can participate in activities set up by other Regions. Therefore, you can continue these relationships that make being a member of this club special.

Finally, our Upstate Area has a good relationship with the Carolinas Region Board and would like to thank them for

their guidance throughout the years, yet it is time for the Upstate Area to become its own PCA region.

This topic will be discussed further at our next Area meeting on Tuesday, April 14th at Quaker Steak & Lube. As an Upstate Area member, your input and feedback are key to making the decision to form our own PCA region, and you will be asked to vote on the topic in the near future.




