From the Driver's Seat

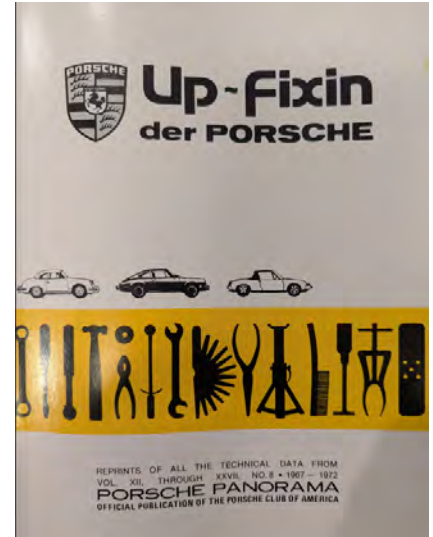
Highway 2026

As Jim is out of the country on vacation, I'm filling in for this month's Drivers Seat.

Does anyone remember Up-Fixin? I came across an assortment of Porsche books in my storage closet recently, and rediscovered the series of books published by PCA. Each book was a compilation of the tech articles that had been published in Panorama. Believe it or not, tech articles were a staple in Panorama back in the old days when it was published in the 7" X 10" format. Each of the 11 volumes contained an index and reprints of all the Panorama tech articles over a 2-4 year period. Volume 11, the last book in the series, was published in 1998. Reading back through the early volumes, illustrates how Pano was such an important source of knowledge for the Porsche community. The articles were written by region members and covered everything from 914 wiring diagrams to 911 transmission rebuilds. If you're interested in the series, occasionally a set will come up for sale in the popular Porsche forums.



Our cars have changed since then and how we get information has changed too. For those who still do their own DIY, we have the internet. Google just about any car repair and you'll have results from YouTube, Reddit, FaceBook and more. Those results aren't better or worse, just different. Faster to market for sure. Publish a YouTube video and within minutes, someone thousands of miles away can view it online. PCA Insider, PCA's own YouTube channel has produced over 220 videos. Yes, our information sources have changed with the times. But that's not news. We've all seen how most published media has had to adapt or cease publication. The big 3 magazines from my youth, Motor Trend, Car & Driver, and Road & Track have all gone to quarterly or bi-monthly editions as they adapt to new norms.

As a region, we've had to adapt too. A few years ago, we made the difficult choice to suspend the print copy of our own newsletter, Tobacco Roads. TR is still being produced, but only to the web. If you're reading this though, you already know that. A little over a year ago, we then began sending out enhanced emails to our region members. The monthly Tobacco Road announcement and the new Region eCalendar Update are examples that provide a richer email with links to event registration or other information links. 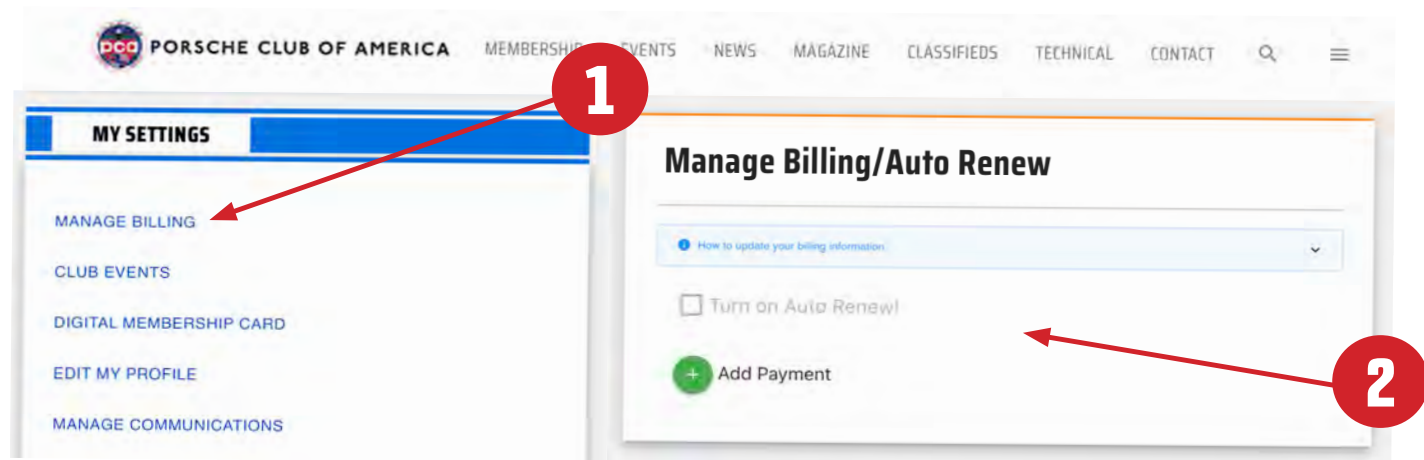

After many years at The Ridges, Fall Tour will shift to a new location in Staunton, Virginia this September. Some activities have taken on new importance. The increased interest in organized drives across the region led to a new region drive chair position and area drive coordinators.

One thing is for sure, the club of 2028 won't look like the club of 1988 or even 2008. Change isn't always easy or well received. The Carolinas Region will continue to adapt, to be fresh and engaging for our membership. I for one, am excited to see where that road will lead us.

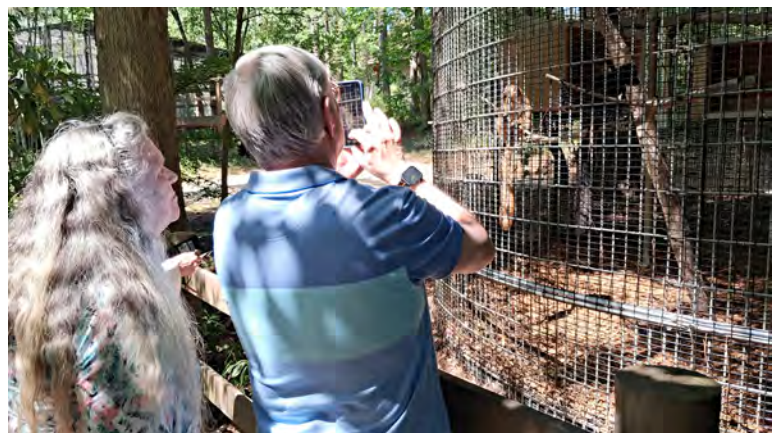

Germany's Best Porsche Roads. From PCA Members, for PCA Members.

Carolinas Region members know good roads. Two PCA couples, Dorian and Katharina Koch from Milwaukee and Torsten and Susanne Weckmann from Germany, are opening up their annual driving tour to a small group of fellow PCA members this September. Eight days, 900 miles, designed for couples, combining great roads, Porsche history, and new friends sharing the same passion.

The route runs from Frankfurt through the Black Forest, along Lake Constance, past Neuschwanstein, to Stuttgart for the Porsche factory tour and museum, through Heidelberg, and back. Local backroads and mountain passes on driving days, with Autobahn legs on the famous no-speed-limit sections. The final night is in Heidelberg, one of Germany's most beautiful cities, with a farewell dinner in the old town. Many unique experiences that can only be experienced in small groups:

4 to 6 couples. That's it.

Every morning, you can choose how you want to drive: on your own following the GPS route, with the sightseeing group at a relaxed pace, or with the spirited group on the roads Porsches were made for. Both groups drive the same route and end up at the same lunch stop, just at a different pace.

Our hotels are unique, local, boutique or castle properties: Schloss Eberstein is a Black Forest hilltop castle first recorded in 1272, with a Michelin-starred restaurant and its own vineyard. The Seegut Zeppelin is a Design Hotels property on a four-hectare lakeside park in Friedrichshafen. In Stuttgart, the group stays at the Porsche Design Tower Hotel, Stuttgart's tallest and most modern building, opened in 2023. Dorian grew up near Wolfsburg and worked for Volkswagen Group and Porsche in Stuttgart-Zuffenhausen before moving to Wisconsin. The two couples have been doing driving tours in Europe for over ten years, always as a passion project. Over 20 tours for 200+ guests since 2017. This is the first one explicitly opened up for PCA members. After joining PCA, Dorian kept hearing how many members wanted a real driving tour in Germany but found the \$15,000+ trips too expensive and not focused enough on driving. This one is \$4,000 per person (plus Porsche rental), with locals showing you the country that brought out the cars we love.
