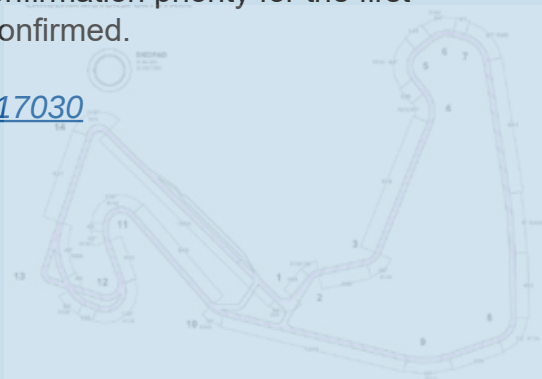

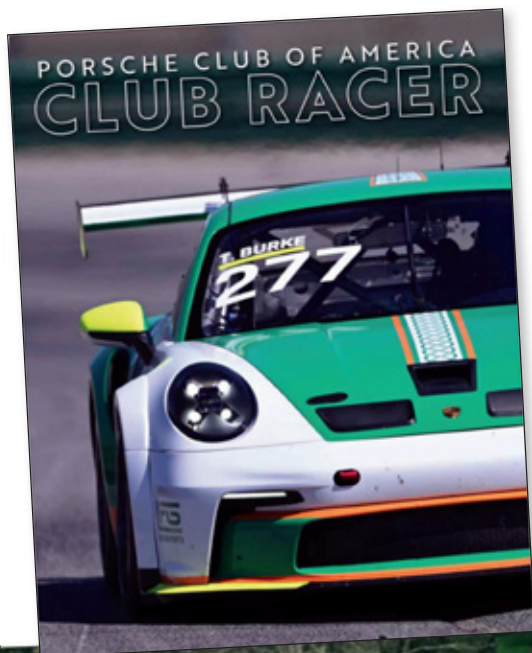

Both John Ridge and Joe Paccadolmi, Greensboro's Porsche Product Specialists, spoke about the new vehicles, their performance and rapid EV recharging times. The new Cayenne Turbo is rated at 1,139hp and can reach 60 mph in 2.4 seconds, which is significantly faster than the Lamborghini Urus of 3.3 seconds. The Cayenne Coupe Electric is rated at 657hp. The DC @ 400kW recharging times from state of charge 10% to 80% in ~16 minutes, which is the fastest in the industry. The Cayenne has a 9.6-kW maximum charging rate for AC charging, which Porsche says can fully recharge the battery from empty to 100 percent SOC in 13 hours.

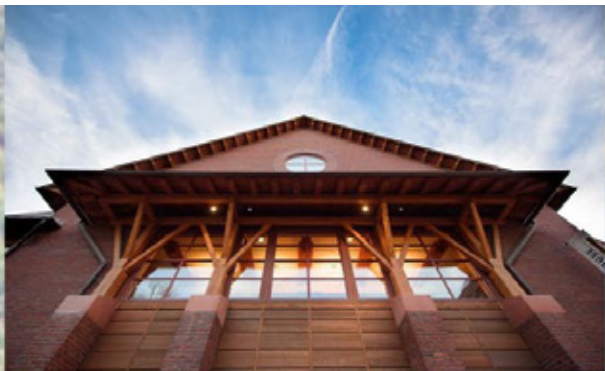

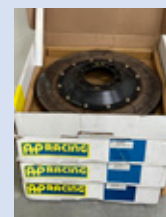
