You will visit: ① ⑤

Upon arrival at Ishigaki port, start your exploration of some of Ishigaki's most popular sights by your comfortable motorcoach and setting off for the first destination, the Tamatorizaki Observatory, overlooking both the Pacific Ocean and the East China Sea. Located in the northern part of the city, the observatory provides views all the way to Ibaruma Bay and Hirakubozaki on clear days. The picture-perfect vistas are enhanced by the incredible hibiscus flowers, which bloom year round. Next, you will visit Yaeyama Palm Tree Grove. Yaeyama palm trees (10m tall) grow wild in the northeastern skirts of Mt. Omoto. The single-genus, single-species Yaeyama palm tree is a rare, large palm which grows wild only in the Yaeyama Islands and has been designated as a national natural monument. Then, enjoy Ishigaki beef lunch - tender type and one of premium Japanese beefs, getting famous worldwide. Continue onto picturesque Kabira Bay, one of the most photographed spots on Ishigaki. Considered the most beautiful spot on the island. Your last visit is Banna Observatory, located in Banna Park - a nature reserve positioned around Banna Dake Mountain, you can see city view of Ishigaki city and Taketomi islands if weather permitting. At the end of this enjoyable day filled with nature and fun, return to port and re-board your ship.

ISG-200 HIGHLIGHTS OF ISHIGAKI (GUIDED IN ENGLISH)

A variety of attractions introduce you to the wonders of Ishigaki as you explore its most popular sites by motorcoach. First stop is Tojin Tomb, a sacred site that honors an 1852 tragedy in Chinese history. Note the Chinese influence in the building's architecture and ornamentation. Nearby, there is also a newer monument dedicated to three American soldiers who were captured in 1945 near the end of World War II. Next door, a candy shop makes and sells its own sugar cane sweets, which you may purchase. Picturesque Kabira Bay, one of the most photographed spots on Ishigaki, is best appreciated from a glassbottom boat. End your day at the Tamatorizaki Observatory, overlooking both the Pacific Ocean and the East China Sea. Return to port at the completion of your day.

ISG-215 TAKETOMI ISLAND (GUIDED IN ENGLISH)



You will visit: ③

Explore the petite islet of Taketomishima and step back in time as you see the sites of this living museum of Ryūkyū heritage. A quick ferry ride will take you to this island with a population under 300. The village charms with red clay roofs, lion sculptures, and volcanic rock walls that are lined with colorful flowers. Water buffalo cart is the means of transportation - and you'll surely enjoy taking a ride through the narrow streets. Stop at Taketomi Island Pier and take a moment to snap a photo, then cross the road to the island's Taketomi Yugafukan Museum, a traditional wooden building that shows videos with stories and music from the region. Later, walk on the "star sand" beach, called Hoshizuna-no-hama, Enjoy the return ferry and motorcoach ride back to port.
