Since turning professional in 1974, Gerry has entertained in jungles, aircraft hangars, been dropped off helicopters in Northern Ireland to entertain the troops, travelled thousands of miles to club and cabaret engagements, and appeared in just about every major theatre in the UK, including the London Palladium. Gerry's first cruise was aboard the Canberra in 1977, and he's been cruising regularly ever since, for P&O, Saga, Fred Olsen, and Airtours, amongst others. In 2005, he appeared as Harry Stubbs in the West End show *Cliff - the Musical*. Very much in demand in UK in panto, variety and Olde Tyme Music Hall, squeaky or cheeky but never blue, his act has been described by Lord Bilston of Bilston as 'Good clean British fun', and he is delighted to be back on board *Saga Ruby*.
