Face to Face Inspection

Upon our arrival in Hirara, a Face to Face inspection is required by the Immigration Officials for all passengers going ashore. This will take place in the Britannia Lounge; entry will be via the Library and exit via the South Cape Bar. You will be required to carry a TLP (Temporary Landing Permit) when you go ashore, and this will be issued to you at the entrance of the Britannia Lounge before the inspection. Please listen out for announcements via the public address system inviting you to the Inspection. Upon your final return to the ship before sailing, please place the TLP in the box provided by the gangway or return it to Reception. If you are remaining on board you will not be required to attend the Inspection.

Shuttle Bus Service

There will be a complimentary shuttle bus service between the ship and the local market area. The first shuttle bus will leave the ship at 9,00am and will run at approximately 15 minute intervals each way throughout our stay. The last shuttle bus will leave the market area at 2.00pm. Within walking distance from the shuttle drop off point is Nishizato Street where you will find the shopping area.

Please note, it is strictly prohibited to take any food ashore in Hirara



Hirara in a nutshell

Hirara is situated on Miyako Island which is known for having some of Japan's best beaches and is a great destination for snorkelling and diving in the coral reefs. The sub tropical climate provides mild weather all year round. It is the fourth largest island in the Okinawa Prefecture. The island is mostly covered by sugar cane fields with a few towns, among which Hirara is the largest with a moderate range of restaurants and bars. The islands making up the Okinawa Prefecture, are also known as the Ryukyu Islands, named after the native culture, which is distinctly different from that of the rest of Japan in terms of language, cuisine and the arts. An independent kingdom and tributary state to China for several centuries, the Ryukyu Islands came under control of the Satsuma feudal system in the 17th century, and were made a Japanese prefecture in 1879.
