

CARE INFO: POONA

CLEANING, REGULAR MAINTENANCE & GENERAL RULES:

Poona is a natural material from thick coir, a coconut husk fiber from the outer shell containing cellulose—most popularly used as a walk-off mat to trap dust, dirt and particles off shoes. Over time, a grayish discoloration will develop keeping with the natural appearance of the coir fiber. It is durable and can last for years if proper care and maintenance is taken. To extend mat life, we suggest:

- Vacuum frequently when dry
- Use a stiff bristle brush or broom and scrape off dry mud, dirt and debris.
- Hang outside if possible and beat out the dust with the end of a broom handle or something similar on both side. If you cannot hang it, use a vacuum without the beater brush suction out all of the dust and dirt particles.
- We do not recommend wet cleaning on Poona mats
