

Piano Department Audition 2024-25 Chopin Repertoire Guidelines

Updated: August 12, 2024

Guidelines

Applicants must prepare two works of Chopin for solo piano. One work must be a slow (i.e., lyrical) selection and one work must be a fast (i.e., virtuosic) selection. Any two works that satisfy both the slow and fast requirements are acceptable if offered together. *The three sonatas and the Andante spianato & Grande polonaise, Op. 22 are the only four works that each satisfy the entirety of the Chopin requirement, as long as offered complete.

Only works from the list below are acceptable. If a work is not listed below, then it is not acceptable. No work for piano and orchestra will be accepted.

Examples of acceptable choices:

Two Etudes (as long as one is fast and one is slow)

Two Ballades

One complete Sonata

One complete set of Mazurkas and a slow piece

A Nocturne and a fast piece

Examples of unacceptable choices:

Two sets of Mazurkas (since neither would satisfy the slow requirement)

Two Nocturnes (since neither would satisfy the fast requirement)
