PRESCHOOL

Through the Pandemic and all the challenges the world throws at us we can always stand on God's Word! Hebrews 13:8 says: "Jesus Christ is the same yesterday, and today, and forever." What a gift; God never changes! In February 2021, we had 46 children attending. In April we had 60 children and in October we had 66 precious children attending and several babies on a wait list. God continues to bring families looking for childcare and preschool. Psalms 57:10 says: "For great is your love, reaching to the heavens; your faithfulness reaches to the skies." We believe that God has His hand on our preschool and through all the challenges, He continues to bring families and shows His faithfulness to us! God is bringing His vision to reality. Every child and family that comes to our preschool hears God's Word and the message of love and salvation. What a privilege to share God's salvation message to so many, and not even in a church service. Being a part of the local outreach ministry of our church is a true gift!

At the beginning of the Pandemic, we lost 8 teachers and only 2 returned. In the past year God has brought 6 wonderful new teachers to continue our vision. We continue following ALL the regulations and protocols set forth by the CDC, Public Health Dept., and Licensing and we thank God no one has gotten sick from COVID at preschool. We can't wait for the day that we can go back to mixing groups and going into the Sanctuary for chapels; but in the meantime, we will continue following all the guidelines and sharing God's love with every family that comes to us!
