# GUESTS COMING IN TO CEREMONY

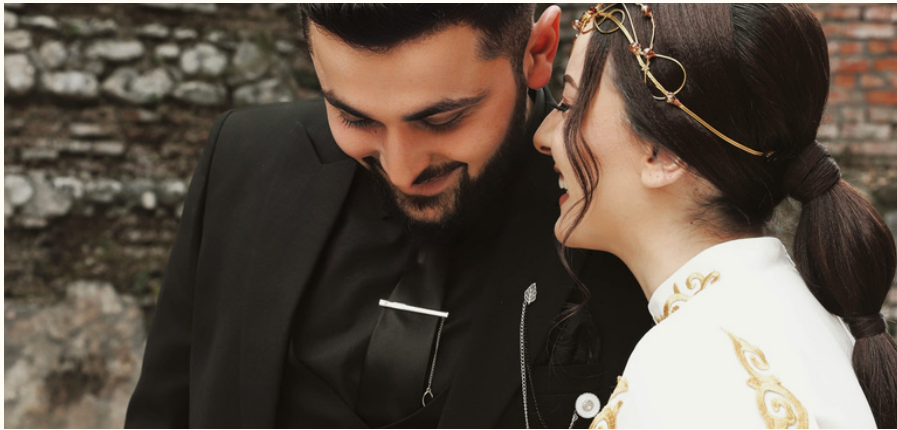
