<u>Our Services</u>

We specialize in providing representation and advice for those looking to obtain a Canadian visa and enter Canada on a temporary or permanent basis. If you need help with your Canadian immigration journey, we can help you with our expertise and experience in a wide range of immigration services such as:





<u>Visitor Visa</u>: Most people need a visa or an Electronic Travel Authorization (eTA) to travel to, or transit through Canada. Visitors are foreign nationals who are not Canadian citizens or permanent residents of Canada who intend to; visit Canada on holiday (vacation), visit family, or conduct business, etc. A visitor visa shows that you meet the requirements needed to enter Canada.

Study Permit: To Study in Canada, you need a study permit. The study permit is a document that is issued to allow foreign nationals to study at designated learning institutions (DLI) in Canada. Most foreign nationals need a study permit to study in Canada. A study permit is usually valid for the length of your study program, plus an extra 90 days. The 90 days let you prepare to leave Canada or apply to extend your study permit and find out about working after you graduate. As an international student, you are allowed to; work while studying, bring family to Canada while studying and your spouse or common-law partner can obtain an open work permit that allows them to work in Canada.

Family Sponsorship: The Family Sponsorship Program allows Canadian Citizens and Permanent Residents to sponsor relatives, including spouse, partner, children, parents, grandparents, and others to immigrate to Canada permanently.

Express Entry: Express Entry Program provides opportunity to skilled immigrants who want to settle in Canada permanently and take part in the Canadian economy. To qualify for this program, you must have the knowledge and education in specific skilled trades and industries.

<u>Provincial Nominees</u>: The Provincial Nominee Program, PNP, allows people to immigrate to Canada by being nominated by a Canadian province or territory. To qualify for this program, you must have the skills, education and work experience required to contribute to the



economy of a specific province or territory and must have expressed an



interest in settling in their province or territory.

Business Immigration:

The Business Immigration Program allows foreign nationals who are entrepreneurs, business owners, investors, start-ups, and those with high net-worth and their families to become Canadian Permanent Residents by expanding foreign business to Canada, starting a business, or investing in an existing one in Canada. This program includes applicants for Start-up Visa, Selfemployed persons, and

Investors.

<u>Start-up Visa Program</u>: For those with an innovative business idea that is endorsed by a participating Canadian organization.

<u>Self-Employed Persons Program</u>: For self-employed persons working in an eligible field.



<u>Other Immigration Programs</u>: Although Express Entry is the main way that Canada welcomes economic immigrants, other available options include, but not limited to the following:

<u>Atlantic Immigration Program</u>: The Atlantic Immigration Program (ATIP) is designed for those who wish to settle in New Brunswick, Nova Scotia, Prince Edward Island, or Newfoundland and Labrador.

<u>Caregivers Programs</u>: The Caregiver Program is for those who intend to



migrate and work in Canada as caregivers. With this program, a person can migrate to provide care for children, the elderly or those with medical needs, or work as a live-in caregiver

Hong Kong: Canada offers immigration programs to skilled workers from Hong Kong.

Agri-Food Immigration Pilot: For agri-food professionals who wish to gain permanent residence.


Rural and Northern Immigration Pilot: The Rural and Northern Immigration Pilot is a communitydriven program. It's designed to

spread the benefits of economic immigration to smaller communities by creating a path to permanent residence for skilled foreign workers who want to work and live in one of the participating communities.



<u>Canadian Refugee Protection Programs</u>: Refugees are people who have fled their countries because of a well-founded fear of persecution. They are not able to return home. They have seen or experienced many horrors. The Canadian refugee system has two main parts:

- the Refugee and Humanitarian Resettlement Program, for people who need protection from outside Canada and
- the In-Canada Asylum Program for people making refugee protection claims from within Canada.



Canada resettles refugees to save lives and to provide stability to those fleeing persecution with no hope of relief. Through its refugee protection system, Canada offers a safe haven to:

- people with a well-founded fear of persecution, and
- people who are outside of their country and cannot return because of that fear of persecution.
