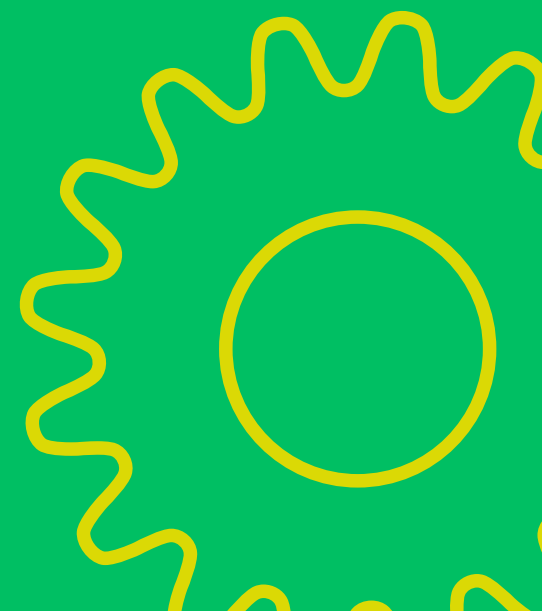

The "Green Inclusion – New Perspectives for the Youth Work Field" project aims to equip youth workers with the necessary skills, tools, and knowledge to integrate climate justice into their work while ensuring the active participation of young people with fewer opportunities (YPWFO) in environmental and community-building initiatives.

LEARNING OBJECTIVES & METHODOLOGY

1. Strengthen the capacity of youth workers to integrate climate justice in their activities by equipping 30 youth workers from 7 countries with inclusive and sustainable methodologies through a international training and collaborative learning.

2. Develop and implement an Inclusive & Sustainable Engagement Instrument that will help youth organizations assess and enhance their capacity to effectively involve YPWFO in climate action and community-building processes.

3. Raise awareness and foster action on climate justice by engaging at least 1,400 individuals across 7 countries through educational activities, advocacy efforts, and the promotion of green inclusive practices in youth work.

The **methodological framework of the project** is based on non formal education with a main focus **on community building about green inclusion.**



IMPORTANT INFORMATION



AGENDA

The agenda and detailed schedule will be available after the final selection of participants. The 1st and 9th of October are arrival and departure days, respectively. There will also be one free afternoon during the program. Training sessions will take place daily between 09:30 and 18:30, with some optional but recommended evening group activities.

This 9-day international training course focuses on Green Inclusion in youth work filed with young people with fewer opportunities (YPWFO). The agenda includes:

- Days 1–2: Arrival, official welcome, team-building, introduction to Erasmus+ and the training context.**
- Days 3–4: In-depth exploration of climate injustice, social inclusion, intersectionality and the role of youth work in systemic change.**
- Days 5–6: Design, development and testing of an Inclusive and Engagement Tool tailored to local realities.**
- Day 7: Harvesting learning outcomes, peer exchange, and mutual support using non-formal methods.**
- Day 8: Presentation of Erasmus+ opportunities, action planning in national groups, and Youthpass competence recognition.**
- Day 9: Final evaluation, feedback, and departure.**

IMPORTANT INFORMATION



SUSTAINABILITY

One of our core educational approaches focuses on environmental education and the embodiment of sustainable behaviors at both individual and organizational levels. Therefore, we integrate the following practices into all our activities:

- **All meals provided during the training will be vegetarian.**
- We encourage green travel whenever possible, especially for participants coming from neighboring countries.
- We will organize and promote selective waste collection, and participants will be expected to contribute to this effort.
- We will use recycled or reused paper and aim to reduce overall material consumption to avoid unnecessary waste.
- Participants will receive detailed information about our environmental sustainability principles, including the reasons behind them, and will be encouraged and supported to actively engage in these efforts.

***All applications will be assessed using the principle of equality of opportunity.**

We are looking for the following profiles:

- **Youth workers, youth leaders, coordinators, educational and career counselors, teachers, general educators, trainers, mentors, coaches or environmental professionals.**
- **A strong calling to participate in this course and a strong and relevant motivation for joining the process. The motivation should be a blend of personal and professional factors.**
- **Each participant must be part of an organization/institution which is connected with the project topics or is willing to incorporate them in the future activities and projects.**
- **Good command of the English language.**
- **Availability to participate in all training sessions.**
- **People older than 18 years and with a legal residence (proven by documents) in the country they are currently residing in.**
- **Residents from Austria, Belgium - DE, Belgium - FL, Belgium - FR, Bulgaria, Croatia, Cyprus, Czech Republic, Denmark, Estonia, Finland, France, Germany, Greece, Hungary, Iceland, Ireland, Italy, Latvia, Liechtenstein, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Malta, Netherlands, Norway, Poland, Portugal, Republic of North Macedonia, Romania, Serbia, Slovak Republic, Slovenia, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland, Turkey**
- **Members or close collaborators of active Youth Organization (staff or active member, paid or not).**

WHAT WILL BE EXPECTED FROM YOU AS A PARTICIPANT?



If you're selected, here's what your involvement will look like:

Before the training

- Take part in an online pre-departure meeting to get to know the team and the plan.
- Do a bit of local research on how climate change affects your community.
- Prepare a few materials for intercultural and thematic sessions.

During the training

- Be present and active in all activities.
- Share your ideas and experiences and support others in the learning process.
- Reflect daily on what you've learned and how you can apply it.

After the training

- Use the Inclusive & Engagement Tool in your organization or community.
- Join your national team to plan a small follow-up activity or awareness campaign.
- Take part in at least one international online meeting to share your progress.

EXPENSES

This training course is funded by Erasmus+, a programme of the European Union. According to its financial rules, some costs are fully covered, such as:

- Board and lodging for the training course are fully covered by the local organizers during the period mentioned in shared rooms (2 to 3 people in one room);**
- Food will be served as a buffet and it will provide only vegan and vegetarian options to comply with the sustainability policy of the project and the hosting organization.**
- Each participant is free to choose the preferred way of travelling. Due to the organizers' policies and the main theme of the project, we strongly encourage the use of green travel. If flights are used for more than 50% of the travel distance the maximum budget allocated available will be from standard travel!**
- The transport support will be transferred into your bank account after receiving the required documents.**

Use [this website](#) to find out your distance. Write at the START, your location, from where you will start your travel and at the END, Busteni, Prahova, Romania. You will get a km number as a result which will correspond to financial support which you may get for your travel costs.

The individual maximum budget for travel, per person, is the following:

10 – 99 km :23 EUR (Standard Travel) / No Green Travel Available

100 – 499 km :180 EUR (Standard Travel) / 210 EUR (Green Travel)

500 – 1999 km :275 EUR (Standard Travel) / 320 EUR (Green Travel)

2000 – 2999 km :360 EUR (Standard Travel) / 410 EUR (Green Travel)

3000 – 3999 km :530 EUR (Standard Travel) / 610 EUR (Green Travel)

4000 – 7999 km : 820 EUR (Standard Travel) / No Green Travel Available
