

EVENTS DESCRIPTION AND RULES

1. RANGOLI:

DESCRIPTION:

The Rangoli Competition is a colorful and creative event that celebrates art, culture, and imagination. Participants create beautiful Rangoli designs using materials such as colour red powders, flowers, rice, sand, and diyas. The event provides a platform for students to showcase their artistic talent, creativity, teamwork, and cultural values.

OBJECTIVES:

- To encourage creativity and artistic expression among participants.
- To provide a platform for students to showcase their talent and imagination.
- To develop teamwork, coordination, and cooperation among participants.
- To create a joyful, colourful, and festive atmosphere during the event.

PARTICIPATION DETAILS:

- Each team can have 4 or less members.
- Individuals may participate as well
- Fee: ₹100 per team

RULES AND REGULATIONS:

1. Maximum participants in a team is 4. Only the team lead will register.
2. To create a joyful, colourful, and festive atmosphere during the event.
3. Each team/participant will be given a fixed time limit to complete the Rangoli.
4. Only the materials given by the organisers may be used
5. The use of stencils, printed outlines, or ready-made Rangoli designs is not allowed.
6. Participants must maintain cleanliness in and around their allotted area.
7. The decision of the judges will be final and binding.

8. Mobile phones or electronic gadgets should not be used during the competition unless permitted.
9. Participants should cooperate with volunteers and organizers to ensure smooth conduct of the event.

2. Wall Graffiti Event (Wall Painting Competition):

BRIFE DESCRIPTION:

Maximum 4 participants can register

ROUNDS:

Round 1: Paper-Based Design Round

- Participants will create a graffiti design on paper
- Participants must bring their own colouring materials (sketch pens, watercolor, etc.)
- Time limit will be provided (e.g., 30–45 minutes)
- Designs will be judged based on creativity, theme relevance, and presentation
- Top participants will qualify for Round 2

Round 2: Wall Graffiti Round

- Qualified participants will paint their design on a wall
- Colors/materials for this round will be provided by the organizers
- Participants must follow the given theme (if any)
- Time limit will be assigned
- Final evaluation will be based on execution, creativity, and overall impact

3. NAIL ART:

BRIEF DESCRIPTION:
