EVENT OVERVIEW:

“Grace & Grit” is a premium women-centric event designed to celebrate confidence, talent, intelligence, stage presence, and resilience. It is not a beauty contest, but a platform where female participants showcase their individuality, communication skills, creativity, leadership potential, and inner strength.

The event creates a classy and empowering atmosphere where participants compete through personality-based rounds, talent showcases, and leadership challenges.

OBJECTIVES:

- To empower female students through self-expression
- To promote confidence and leadership qualities
- To provide a platform for showcasing talent and personality
- To celebrate grace, grit, and individuality
- To inspire healthy and positive competition

ELIGIBILITY:

- Open only to female students
- Individual participation only
- Students from all years and departments are eligible
- College ID card is mandatory

EVENT FORMAT / FLOW:

Step 1: Registration

Participants will register individually for the competition.

College ID verification will be done during registration.

Step 2: Introduction & Briefing

Participants will receive briefing regarding event rules, judging criteria, stage instructions, and time limits.

EVENT STRUCTURE / ROUNDS:

ROUND 1: INTRODUCTION ROUND

Objective:

To judge confidence, communication skills, and personality.

Format:

Each participant will get 45–60 seconds to introduce herself.

Participants may include:

- Name
- Department / Year
- Passion or interests
- One personal strength
- Why they joined “Grace & Grit”

ROUND 2: TALENT ROUND

Objective:

To showcase participants’ creativity and unique abilities.

Time Limit:

2–3 minutes per participant

Examples of Performances:

- Poetry
- Acting
- Mimicry
- Storytelling
- Painting
- Martial Arts Demonstration
- Spoken Word
- Stand-up Comedy
- Instrumental Performance (optional)

ROUND 3: WIT & PRESENCE (RAPID FIRE)

Objective:

To test spontaneity, confidence, and thinking ability.

Format:

Participants will answer quick questions within 1 minute.

Sample Questions:

- One thing every woman should believe in?
- Success or happiness? Why?
- Describe yourself in one word.
- If you lead the college for one day, what would you change?

ROUND 4: SITUATION CHALLENGE

Objective:

To evaluate leadership qualities and decision-making abilities.

Example Situations:

- You see someone being bullied on campus.
- You fail before an important competition.
- You lead a team facing conflicts.

ROUND 5: GRAND FINALE Q&A

Objective:

To assess maturity, perspective, and inspirational thinking.

Eligibility:

Top 5 finalists only.

Sample Questions:

- What does empowerment mean to you?
- How should society support ambitious women?
- What legacy do you want to create?

JUDGING CRITERIA:

Participants will be evaluated based on:

- Confidence
- Communication Skills
- Talent & Creativity
- Presence of Mind
- Stage Presence
- Overall Personality

WINNING TITLES:

Main Titles:

- Grace & Grit Champion
- 1st Runner-Up
- 2nd Runner-Up

Special Titles:

- Miss Confidence
- Miss Elegance
- Miss Talent
- Miss Charisma
- Audience Choice

RULES & REGULATIONS:

- Respectful behavior is mandatory throughout the event.
- Vulgar, offensive, or inappropriate content is strictly prohibited.
- Participants must strictly follow the allotted time limits.
- Dangerous or unsafe performances are not allowed.
- Participants must cooperate with organizers and volunteers.
- Any unfair means may lead to disqualification.
- The decision of judges and organizers will be final and binding.

WHY THIS EVENT IS SPECIAL:

“Grace & Grit” highlights the strength, confidence, intelligence, and brilliance of women while creating a classy, empowering, and inspiring atmosphere during Zephyr 2k26.

The event focuses on personality, talent, leadership, and individuality rather than appearance, making it a meaningful platform for female empowerment.
