CAPTAIN (ROTATIONAL)

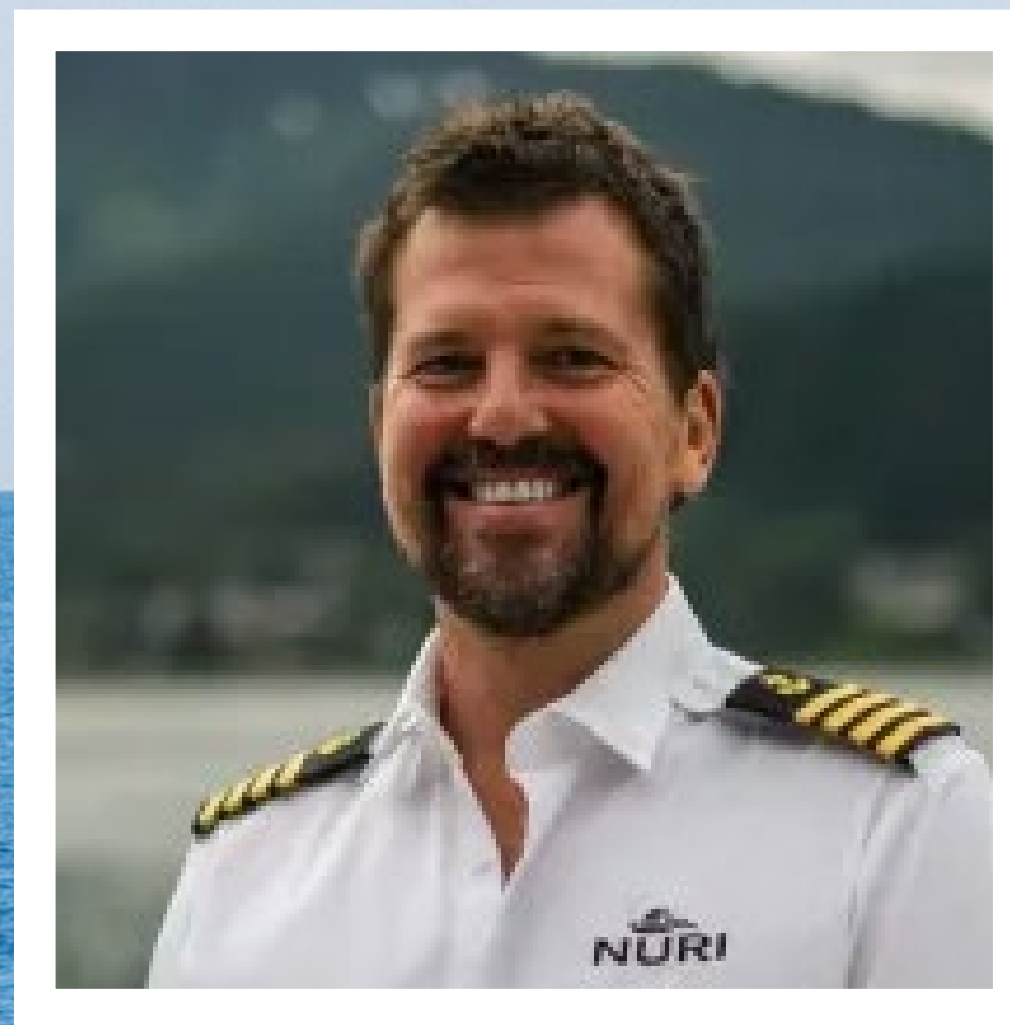

NATIONALITY: SOUTH AFRICAN

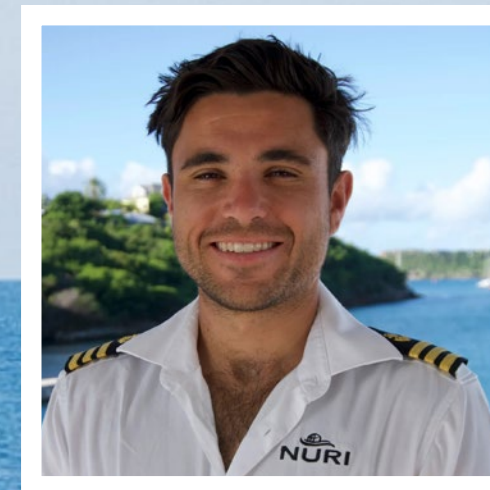

ROBERT BLOOMFIELD

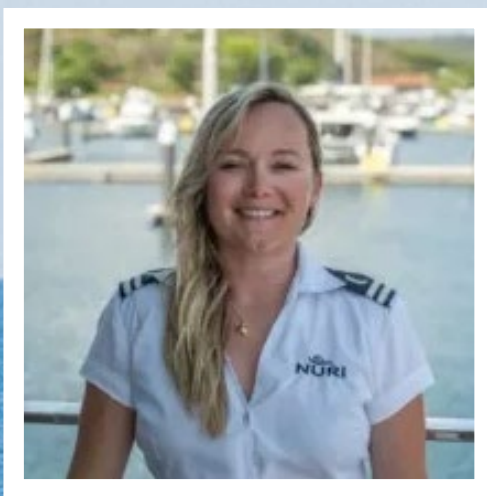
DECKHAND / ASSISTANT ENGINEER

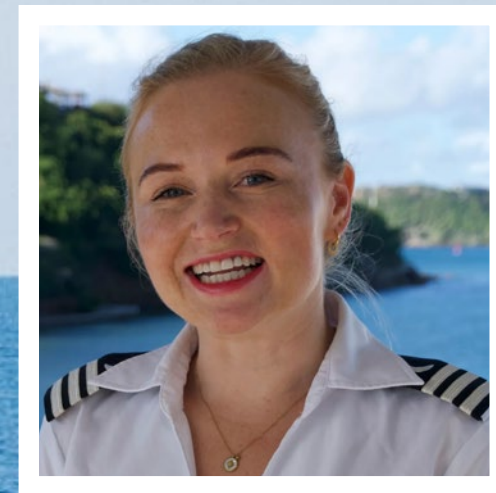
NINA LOUW

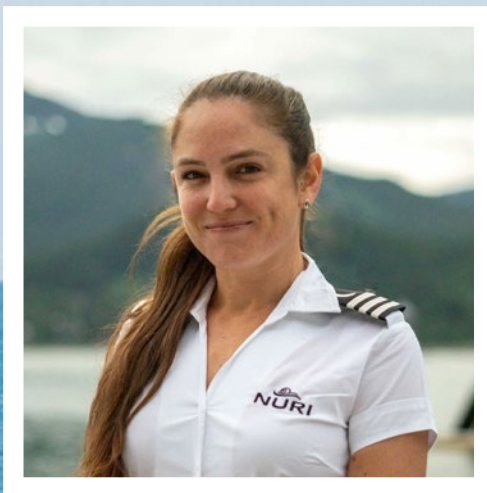
CHIEF STEWARDESS (ROTATIONAL)

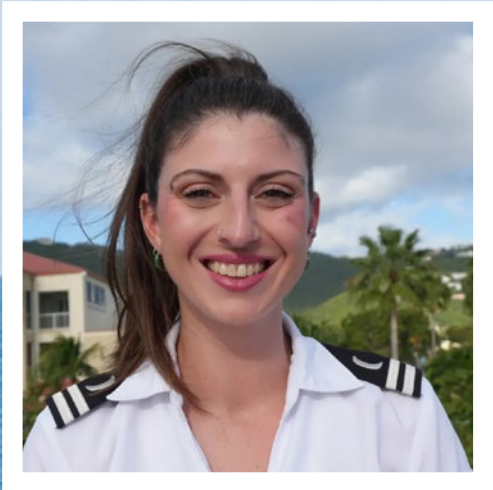

MARTIN FALZI

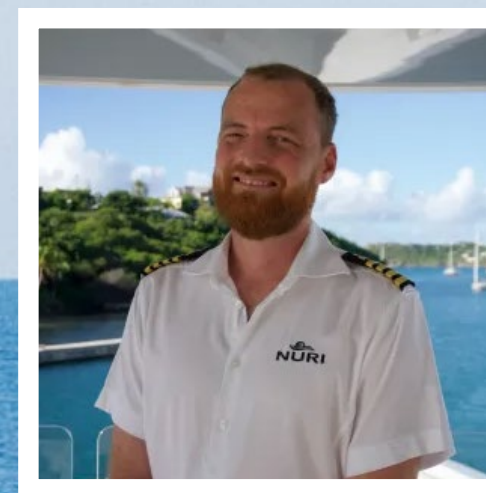
CHIEF ENGINEER (ROTATIONAL)
