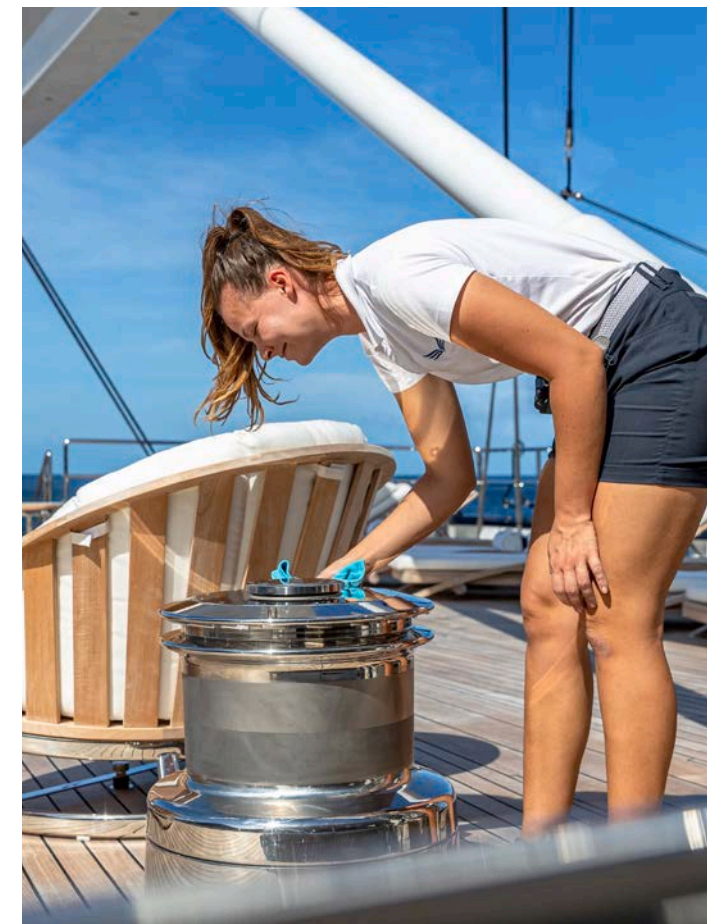
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HENRY SAY

LUKE HOSKINS

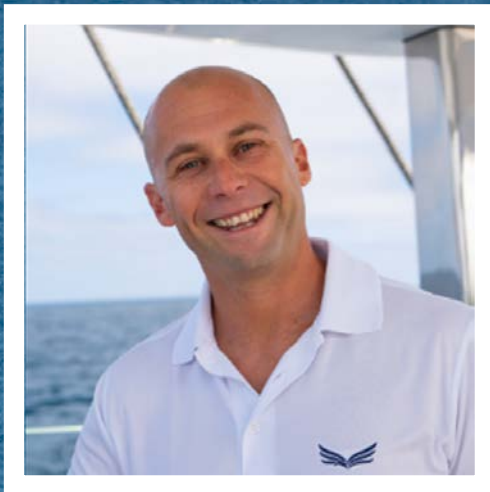
CAPTAIN (ROTATIONAL)

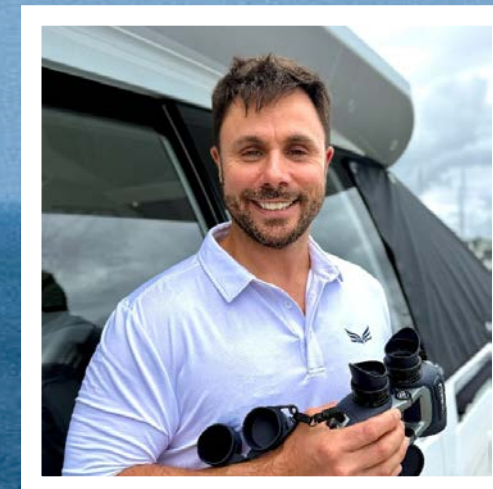
CHARLES ST GERMAIN

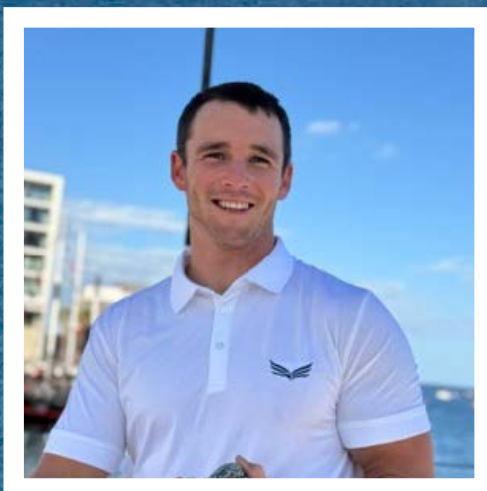
NOAH CUMMING

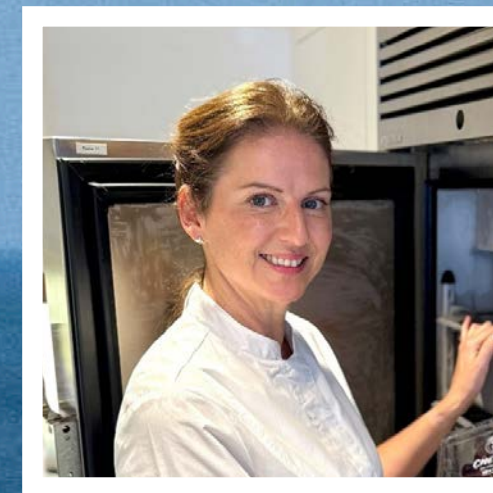
JEMMA HARRISON

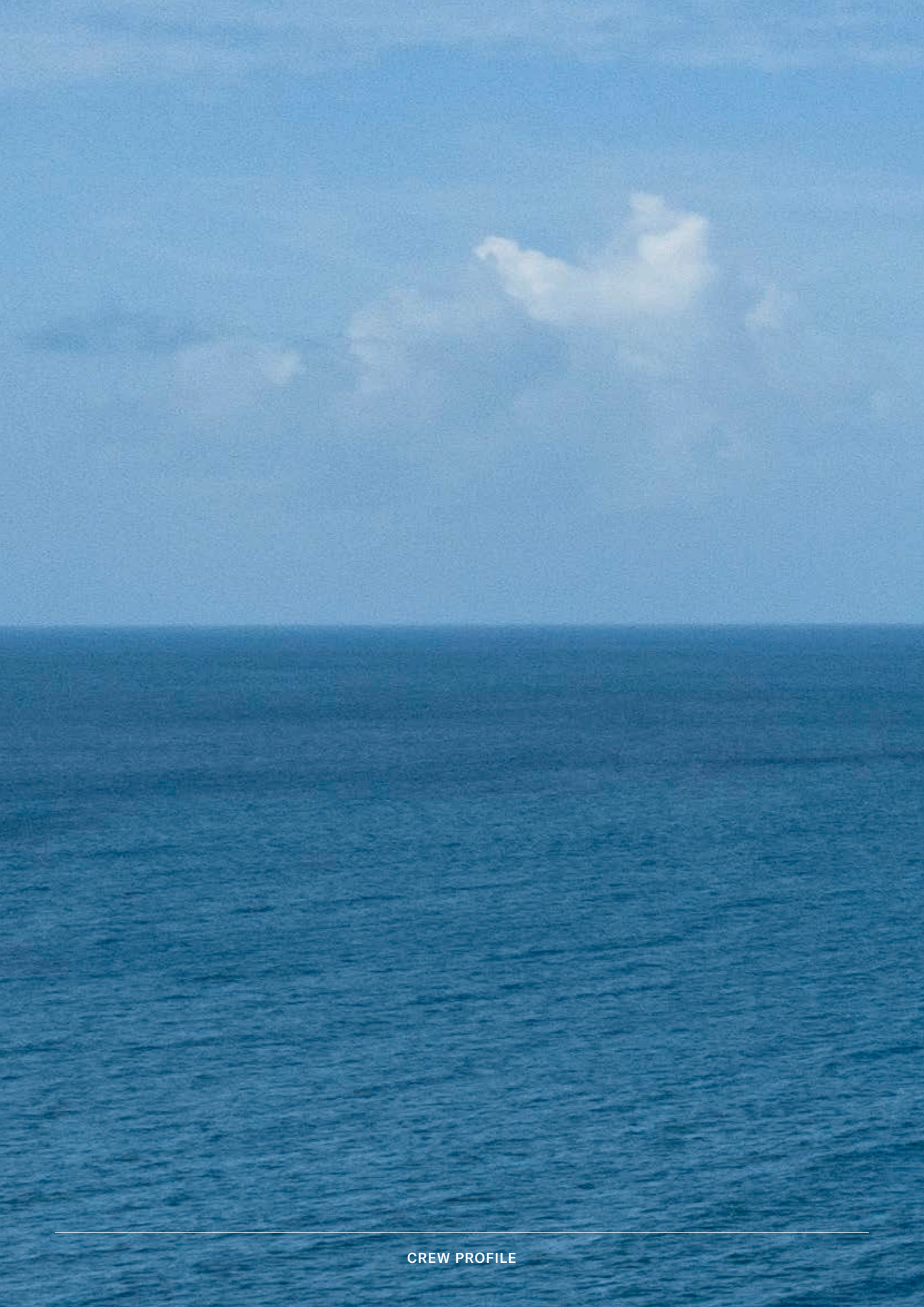
HEAD CHEF (ROTATIONAL)

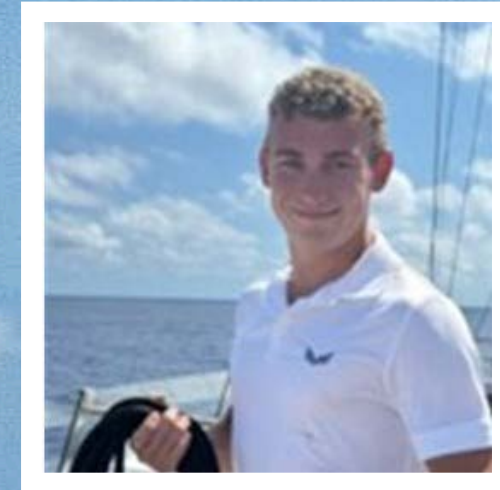

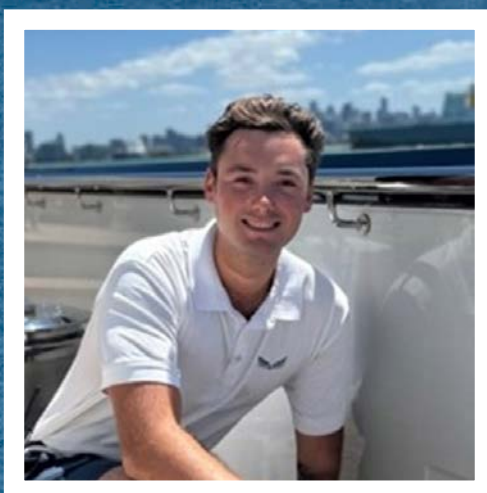


ADAM BAGNALL

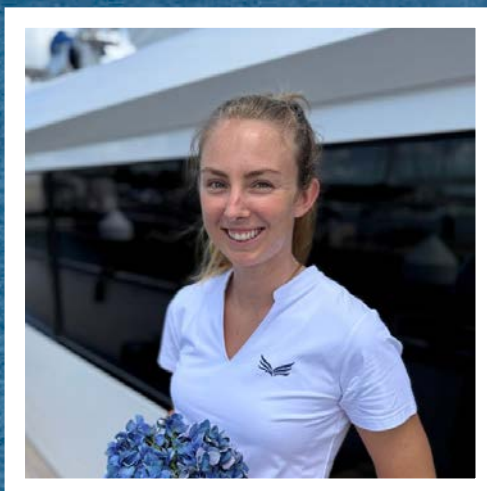
ROSIE ELVIDGE

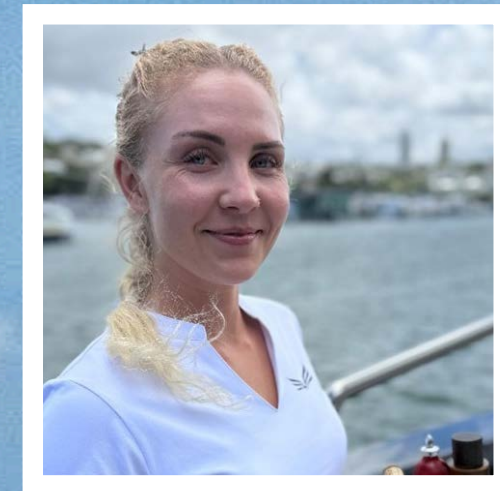

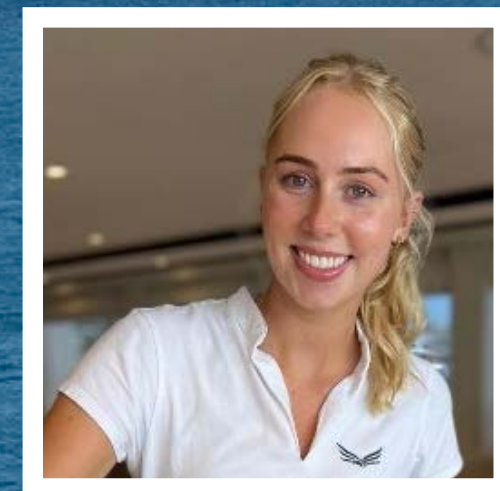


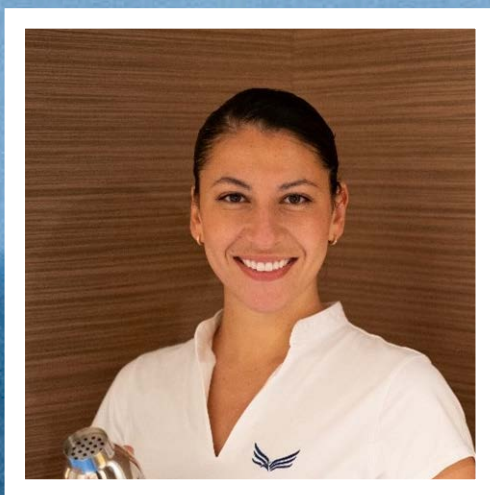
IRELAND MILN
