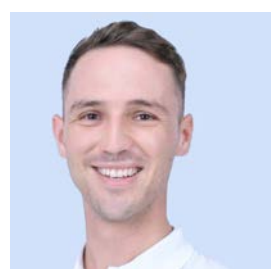

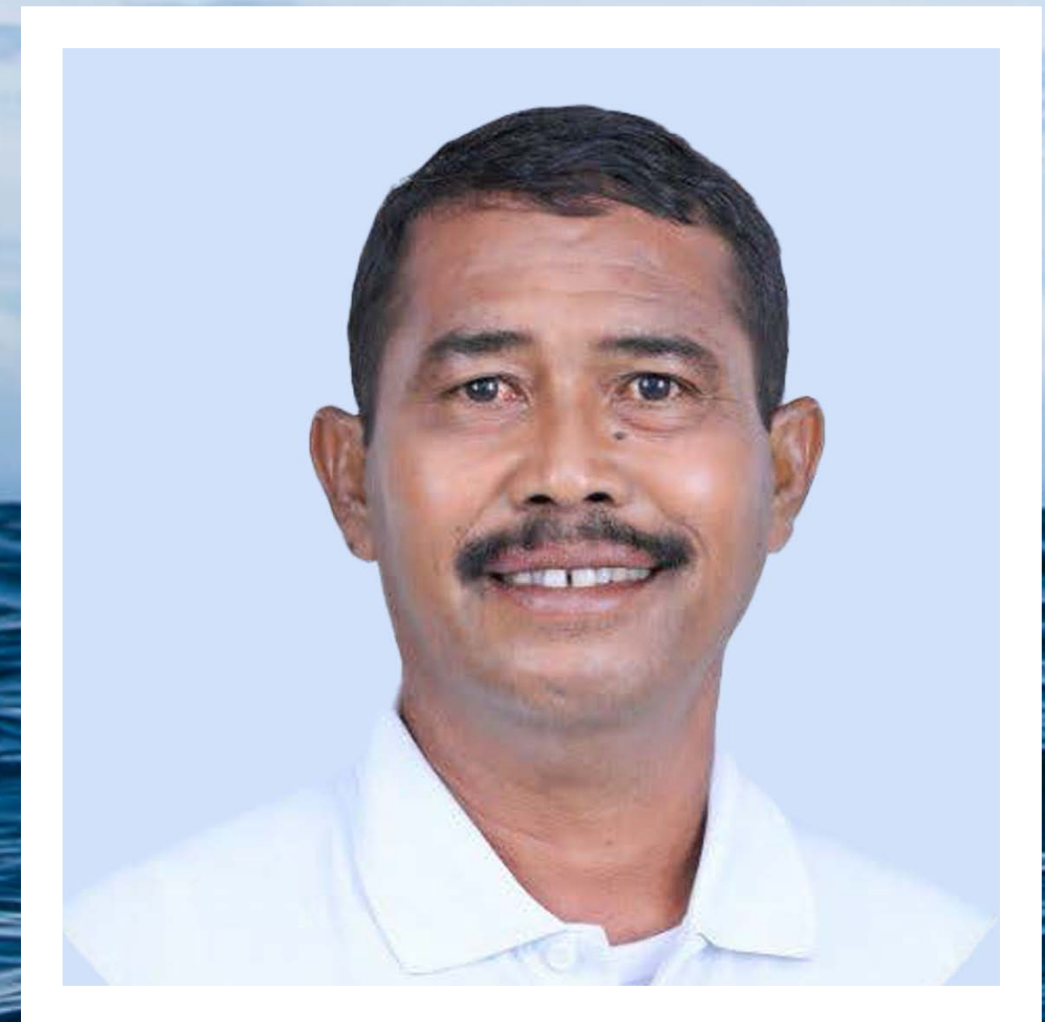


LA SUWU

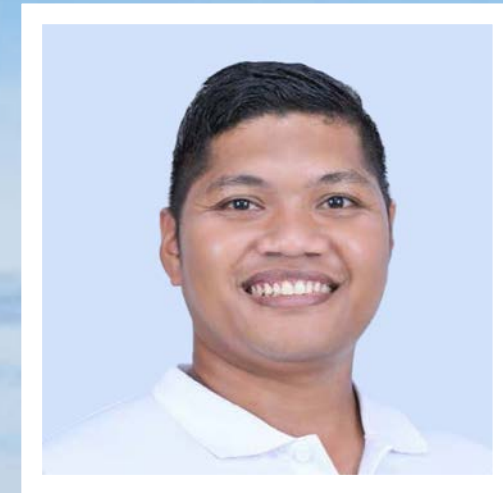
